Judges: In addition to any minimum qualifications promulgated by the Commission, all applicants for the position of race judge must be certified by a national organization approved by the Commission. An applicant for the position of race judge must also have been previously employed as a Steward, Presiding, Judge, Associate Judge, or other racing official at a harness racing meeting for a period of not less than 45 days during 3 of the past 5 years, or have at least 5 years of experience as a licensed harness racing driver who has served more than one year as a licensed racing official at a harness racing meeting or have 10 years of experience as a licensed harness racing trainer who has served more than 1 year as a licensed racing official at a harness racing meeting. All Commission Officials must meet regulatory requirements to obtain and maintain a Racing Official's license.

Salary and benefit packages are competitive with the Mid Atlantic region.
