Two More Delaware Farmers' Markets Open This Week

Trolley Square & Hockessin Make Slight Changes for 2007 Season

Wilmington- The 2007 Delaware Farmers' Market season rolls on this week with the grand opening of two additional farmers' markets. The Trolley Square Farmers' Market located in the courtyard of Natural Evolution Health Food Store at 1715 Delaware Avenue in Wilmington opens Friday, June 1st and the Hockessin Farmers' Market located at Hockessin Corner on Route 41 in Hockessin also opens Friday, June 1st.

The vendors at each market will offer a variety of locally grown, delicious, fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs, flowers, nursery items, baked goods and more.

The Trolley Square Farmers' Market has been in operation for two seasons and will open every Friday, 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. through September 14th. The owner of Natural Evolution Health Food Store, Joe Turtoro has stepped up to plate and is the new market manager for the Trolley Square market.

The Hockessin Farmer' Market, also in operation for two seasons, will open every Friday, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. through October 26th.

Delaware will have a total of 10 farmers' markets this season statewide.
