In keeping with HB 425, during Pilot Program A, seventy-five percent of the funding will be utilized for income eligible Delawareans and twenty-five percent of the funds will be dedicated to subsidizing cost of sterilizing abandoned/free-roaming/homeless/stray/unwanted animals. In order to meet the needs of income eligible Delawareans, a veterinary practice in each county is participating in the program and further information on these practices will be provided by the DDA Spay/Neuter Program. Delaware Animal Care & Control (formerly known as Kent County SPCA) will receive funding for sterilizing the abandoned/free-roaming/homeless/stray/unwanted animals.
