Reminder for Delaware Farmers and other livestock operations

Deadline to submit a Notice of Intent to apply for a CAFO permit is February 9, 2011

New regulations concerning Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) in Delaware which became effective beginning November 11, 2010 mandate that poultry farmers and livestock operations in the First State that are identified as CAFOs must apply for a CAFO permit within 90 days of November 11, 2010. To apply for the permit, farmers and other livestock operators must send a signed Notice of Intent (NOI) and a copy of their most recent nutrient management plan (NMP) or animal waste management plan (AWMP) to the Delaware Department of Agriculture (DDA) on or before February 9, 2010.

Producers and the public that have questions about CAFOs and the regulations may go the DDA website www.dda.delaware.gov and find a copy of the regulations, Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs), and the NOI form.
