**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** #1, “My Charming Clyde,” was claimed by Jagger Inc. – Jamie Ness. The Owner and Trainer that claimed the #1, “My Charming Clyde,” requested an all-inclusive special test.

After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined that the #4 came out very little while clear of the #1. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. Jockeys Brian Pedroza and Shane Spieth will be required to attend the film review for this race on Monday, May 30, 2016.

The starter also confirmed that the horse had the opportunity for a fair start. The Stewards were informed by the Starter that “Cho Time” was placed on the starter’s list and furthermore will not be able to race until additional schooling and successful breaking habits are established.
