**Administrative Hearings:**

Jockeys Brian Pedroza, Shane Spieth, and all apprentice riders are required to attend the film review today at 12:00 noon. The film review concerned a claim of foul by Mr. Pedroza against Mr. Spieth in the 4<sup>th</sup> race on Saturday, May 28, 2016. As a result of the hearing, no action was taken against Mr. Spieth or Mr. Pedroza.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m.** #6, “My Man Dan,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake, #4, “Mavericks Gun,” was claimed by Juan Arriagada – Allison Hassig

**ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m.** We received a call from Horse Identifier, Ms. Pam Ritter stating that the #1, “Gigi’s Lollipop,” had an incorrect lip tattoo. The mistake was concerning the fifth digit which is the #3, instead of #6. The proper tattoo number for the Bay Gelding is P-15366 but the technician had entered # P-15336 which belonged to a Chestnut Filly. Horse Identifier, Ritter and Tattoo Technician Ms. Sharon Gunther identified the horse by the markings registered on the foal certificate as the Bay Gelding “Gigi’s Lollipop,” which is the proper horse entered and running. A correction will be made to the tattoo number of the horse “Gigi’s Lollipop,” as soon as possible. #5, “Love the Beat,” was claimed by Martin Alicea – George Diaz. #4, “Littlebuzz,” was scratched by the Stewards due to the horse had lost its hind shoe, and the paddock blacksmith could not get a new shoe on the horse.

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.** #3, “Hold Me Tight,” hesitated at the start breaking slowly.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 6**

**FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m.** #3, “Molly O’Shea,” #4, “Yonka,” and #9, “Alma Lianera,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #5, “My Adeline,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m.**

**INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH. Hold and claims of foul** by jockey Gabriel Saez of the #2, “Bluegrass Beat,” jockey Scott Spieth and trainer Timothy Ritchey of the #6, “Royal Marine,” against the #3, “Hauler,” ridden by Ashley Castrenze. The claim of foul was in reference to the #3, “Hauler,” coming out at the top of the stretch forcing out the #2, “Bluegrass Beat,” and the #6, “Royal Marine.” After interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #3, “Hauler,” and placed him third. The #2, “Bluegrass Beat,” was moved up to first and the #6, “Royal Marine,” up to second. Movies will be held on June 1, 2016 for the benefit of jockeys Castrenze, Saez and Spieth concerning this race. #4, “Holy Soldier,” was a vet scratch. #1, “A.P. Cino,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 5**

**SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:21 p.m.**

This race was scheduled at seven and one half furlongs on the turf, but ran at one mile on the main track. #6, “Wowwhatabrat,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Broken Bridle,” #2, “Louise’s Legacy,” #4, “Pop Rocks Lady,” #7, “Hitting Spree,” and #10, “Emyvale Court,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #8, “Strong Gale,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 11 - 3.” Starters - 5**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:51 p.m.** #5, “Taipan’s Advantage,” was a vet scratch.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 1 - 8.” Starters – 7**

**NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:20 p.m.**

**INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Kevin Mendez of the #5, “Lady Haha,” against the #7, “Charich,” ridden by Travis Wales. The claim of foul was in reference to the #7, “Charich,” coming in during the stretch run forcing Jockey Mendez on the #5, “Lady Haha,” to take hold of his mount and go around the #7, ridden by Jockey Wales. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #7, “Charich,” and placed him second. Consequently, #5, “Lady Haha,” was moved up to first.
