Administrative Hearings:

Jockey Agent Mr. Mark Mace has waived his right to a hearing, as his rider Mr. Brian Pedroza, was named and checked on a mount for Saturday May 21, 2016. Mr. Pedroza had taken off the horse failing to honor the call. Mr. Mace will be fined \$200.00 dollars for the violation of DTRC rules 9.5 and 9.5.1

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #1, “Donna Di Treviso,” was a vet scratch.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:45 p.m. #4, “Lil’ Smartiepants,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.

This race was scheduled at seven and one half furlongs on the turf, but ran at one mile on the main track. Brian Pedroza, named on #10, “Tens Wild,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #8, “Tap’n My Toes,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #11, “Brasstown Sheriff,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Uncle Harry,” #12, “Guts and Glory,” and #14, “Big Johnny D (IRE),” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #2, “Grey Gator,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Bluegrass Chat,” stumbled at the start.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 9

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. #1, “Read the Headlines,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Zimbabwe Lady,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Seeyouinthetown,” was claimed by Bruno Schickendanz – Aldana Gonzalez. #8, “Lewis Meadow,” was claimed by Drawing Away Stable – Wayne Potts. #5, “Proulette,” stumbled and fell after the race while pulling up, unseating its rider, Erasmo Martinez. The rider of the #7, “Anita,” Carol Cedeno jumped off her horse, after avoiding the fallen horse. Ms. Cedeno was uninjured. Jockey Erasmo Martinez was taken to hospital for further evaluation. The horse “Proulette” was placed on the Stewards List making him ineligible to race in Delaware due to falling in two of his last five starts.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 8 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. #2, “Prospecting Road,” collapsed after the race while pulling up. The rider of the #2, Kevin Gomez was not injured, as he had stepped off the horse before it fell. A necropsy on “Prospecting Road” was ordered by the DTRC Executive Director.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 7

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. #4, “Sleeting,” #6, “Half Irish,” #7, “Emyvale Court,” #8, “Hassah (GB),” and #10, “Leafy Shade (GB),” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #9, “Vale Ridge,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #5, “Hitting Spree,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 3 - 11.” Starters - 5

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. Erasmo Martinez, named on #1, “Yo Soy El Lobo,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. #2, “Blue Humor,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 7

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:24 p.m. #2, “Spook AA,” and #3, “Sweet Honey AA,” both flipped in the starting gate. The #2 and #3 were scratched by the Stewards upon recommendation of Associate Commission Veterinarian Dr. Richard Brown. The rider of the #2 Deirdre Panas and Travis Whales the rider of the #3 were uninjured, after being unseated at the gate. 2, “Spook AA,” and #3, “Sweet Honey AA,” were placed on the Starters and Vets list. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. Ricardo Chiappe, the jockey on the winner, “R B Nash” will be called into the Stewards office for apparent overuse of the whip. We noted that the rider never looked back to see how far in front he was and finished over thirty lengths ahead of the second place horse.
