Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from May 21, 2016 are clear.
- All Samples from May 23, 2016 are clear, with the exception of samples #17554 and #17592 which were placed on hold.
- Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #17554, taken from the horse “Michaels Butterfly” which ran in the 4th race on Saturday, May 23, 2016, contained “Glaucine,” in the amount of 509 picograms per milliliter of plasma and 0.8 nanograms of urine. The trainer of record, Ms. Gina Rosenthal, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. Ms. Rosenthal is not stabled at Delaware Park and was not subjected to a barn search. This sample will be placed on hold until final adjunction.
- Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #17592, taken from the horse “Truth Only” which ran in the 2nd race on Saturday, May 23, 2016, contained “diclofenac,” in the amount of 6.7 nanograms per milliliter of plasma. The trainer of record, Ms. Aldana Gonzalez, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift and Gowen conducted an inspection of Trainer Gonzalez assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. Ms. Gonzalez waived her right to a split sample and a hearing in this matter, and accepted a fine of Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00) for this violation.
