Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from May 25, 2016 are clear, with the exception of sample #17504 which was placed on hold.
- All Samples from May 28, 2016 are clear.
- All Samples from May 30, 2016 are clear.
- All Samples from June 1, 2016 are clear, with the exception of samples #17556 and #17584 which were placed on hold.
- Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #17504, taken from the horse “Brooks Lass” which ran in the 4th race on Wednesday, May 25, 2016, contained “Glaucine,” in the amount of 900 picograms per milliliter of plasma and 5.9 nanograms of urine. The trainer of record, Mr. Scott Lake, was informed of the laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift and Gowen conducted an inspection of Trainer Lake’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. This sample will be placed on hold until final adjunction.
