ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m.
INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH. Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Trevor McCarthy of the #8, “King Gatto,” against the #1, “Mach Trial,” ridden by Ricardo Chiappe, and the #2, “Thurgood,” ridden by Katie Davis. The claim of foul was in reference to the #1, “Mach Trial,” coming out in the stretch and the #2, “Thurgood,” coming in during the stretch run, forcing the rider of #8, “King Gatto,” to check his mount. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #1, “Mach Trial,” from third and placed him fifth with the #2, “Thurgood,” disqualified from fourth and placed sixth. The disqualification was for causing the #8, “King Gatto,” to check in the stretch run. Movies will be held on 6-16-16 for Ms. Katie Davis, Mr. Ricardo Chiappe and Mr. Trevor McCarthy concerning this race. #3, “Super Fund,” was scratched as a main-track only. #6, “Two Step Temper,” was selected for a blood gas test.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:24 p.m. Gary Whales, named on #4, “Boulevard,” was changed to Cecily Evans; no double jocks mount.

FOURTH RACE – THE INTERNATIONAL LADIES FEGENTRI - ON THE TURF – POST TIME – 2:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:54 p.m. #5, “Hokie Player,” was scratched as the van broke down; a tow and repair slip will be required from the trainer. #9, “Dulce Vida,” was selected for a blood gas test. The saddle on the #9, ‘Dulce,’ slipped to the side on the first turn and the rider kicked her feet out of the stirrups and finished the race. #1, “Marriage Material,” was getting out severely on the first turn. We endured a tote delay of approximately five minutes as one outlet pools were delayed in being sent.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:25 p.m. #5, “Redworriress,” was selected for a blood gas test.

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:55 p.m. Vicky Baez, named on #1a, “Harumi,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. Cecily Evans, named on #2b, “Frisbee,” was changed to Vince Halliday; no double jocks mount. #4, “Charlotte’s Girl,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Final Betrayal,” and #10, “Key to the Highway,” were scratched as a main-track only. #5, “No See Um,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #8, “Mirkanurka,” was scratched by the Stewards upon recommendation of Associate Commission Veterinarian Dr. Richard Brown, who stated that the horse was not warming up well. Dr. Brown said the horse was off in the right rear, and placed on the vets list requiring a workout with blood being drawn before being re-entered.
