The Stewards attended the Delaware Racing Commission meeting today at 10:05 a.m.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from June 1, 2016 are clear.
- All Samples from June 2, 2016 are clear.
- Samples from June 4, 2016 were cleared, with the exception of samples #17534, #17547 and #17568 which were placed on hold.
- Samples from June 6, 2016 were cleared, with the exception of samples #16516 and #17632 which were placed on hold.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #7, “Don’t Think Twice,”** was a vet scratch. #1, “Skiffs Brewmeister,” was claimed by John Rigattieri & Manfred Roos - John Rigattieri.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:49 p.m. #8, “Flashy Bargirl.”** was scratched by the racing office. #6, “Gold Value,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 5 - 9.” Starters - 9**

**THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. #6, “Mochkla Mochkla,”** was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #9, “Tizthefastlaine,” was scratched as a main-track only.

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:50 p.m.** #6, “Lake Creek,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “My Charming Clyde,” was claimed by Top Hat Thoroughbreds – Wayne Potts. #7, “Faithful Servant,” broke to the outside at the start.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – 6 - 4 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 7**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:21 p.m.**  
**INQUIRY AT THE SIX AND ONE HALF FURLONG MARKER – #1, “Love the Beat”** attempted to jump the inside rail, hitting the rail very hard. The rider of the #1, Gabriel Saez was not unseated, and pulled his horse up at the five-eighth’s pole before dismounting. #2, “Fast Flying Fred,” was selected for a blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 10 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 11**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m.** #7, “Russian Spring,” was a vet scratch.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m.**  
**INQUIRY AT THE FOUR AND ONE HALF FURLONG MARKER. Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Ricardo Chiappe of the #6, “Don Ave,” against the #9, “Tampa Bay Blue,” ridden by Silvestre Gonzalez. The claim of foul was in reference to the #9, “Tampa Bay Blue,” coming over in front of the #6 down the backstretch forcing the rider of #6, “Don Ave,” to check his mount. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #9, “Tampa Bay Blue,” from third and placed him eighth moving the #6, “Don Ave,” up to seventh. We also had a claim of foul by Augusto Marin the rider of the #8, “Mangrove Pond,” against the #7, “Thepresidentallion,” and Vince Halliday for coming in during the stretch run and shutting him off causing him to check his mount. After reviewing the films of the alleged incident in the stretch run the #8, “Mangrove Pond,” was inside the gap at the chute and came out over the heels of the #7. The Stewards could see no reason to take any action in this incident and made the race official. Movies will be held for Mr. Silvestre Gonzalez, Mr. Ricardo Chiappe, Mr. Augusto Marin, and Mr. Vince Halliday concerning this race on Thursday, June 16, 2016. Joshua Navarro, named on #3, “Trouble With Girls,” was changed to Diego Gomez; no double jocks mount. Kevin Mendez, named on #4, “Star of Magic,” was changed to Travis Wales; double jocks mount. #9, “Tampa Bay Blue,” was selected for a blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 9**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:57 p.m.** The #3, “Benny’s Diamond,” broke down at the three-eight’s pole, was pulled up by jockey Jason Nguyen who dismounted holding the horse until the outrider arrived. Chief Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts reported that the horse had injured its right knee. The #3, “Benny’s Diamond,” was removed from the racing surface via the horse ambulance, and later was humanely destroyed for a fractured knee. #2, “Image,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 1 - 4.” Starters – 5**
