



# Daily Log Stewards Report Delaware Park

Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

### Administrative:

Dr. Craig Goldblatt is the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarian.

### **Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:**

- All Samples from June 9, 2016 are clear.
- All Samples from June 11, 2016 are clear, with the exception of sample #17695 which was placed on hold.
- All Samples from June 13, 2016 are clear, with the exception of sample #16191 which was placed on hold.
- Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #17547, taken from the horse “Newport Red” which ran in the 7th race on Saturday, June 4, 2016, contained “Glaucine,” in the amount of 1300 picograms per milliliter of plasma and 20.3 nanograms of urine. Mr. Lake also had “Glaucine,” in the amount of 800 picograms per milliliter of plasma in the Stewards special test sample #16135 on Saturday, June 4, 2016. The horse “Uncle Carm,” was a vet scratch, as the horse had developed hives. The trainer of record, Mr. Scott Lake, was informed of the laboratory findings by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift, Delaney, and Gowan, conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Lake’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. Both samples will be placed on hold until final adjunction.
- Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #17534, taken from the horse “Magic Lion” which ran in the 4th race on Saturday, June 4, 2016, contained “Glaucine,” in the amount of 375 picograms per milliliter of plasma and 1.02 nanograms of urine. The trainer of record, Kieron Magee, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. Mr. Magee is not stabled at Delaware Park and was not subjected to a barn search. This sample will be placed on hold until final adjunction.

• Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #17632, taken from the horse “Lil’ Smartiepants” which ran in the 2nd race on Monday, June 6, 2016, contained “Flunixin,” in the amount of 6.6 nanograms per milliliter of plasma and “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 0.86 micrograms of plasma. The trainer of record, Mr. Richard Vega, was informed of the laboratory findings by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift, Delaney, and Gowan, conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Vega’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. Mr. Vega has waived his right to a split sample and a hearing concerning this matter, accepting the Stewards decision of a \$500.00 fine and one point on the MMV point system.

**Administrative Hearings:**

We held a hearing on Tuesday, June 21, 2016 for trainer Mr. Michael Lerman concerning his entering the horse “Black Mission Fig” at two different tracks on the same day. Consequently, Mr. Lerman scratched his horse from the 8<sup>th</sup> race at Delaware Park on 5-23-16 running the horse at Penn National on Saturday, May 21, 2016. As a result of his actions which were deemed in violation of Commission rules 3.4, 3.4.1.15 and 11.14.1.5, he was fined the sum of \$1,000.00. Mr. Lerman has indicated that he will appeal the Stewards decision to the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission.

During a hearing on Tuesday, June 21, 2016, Exercise Rider Mr. Juan Victoriano was questioned regarding damage he caused to Delaware Park property by running through the front wall of barn 19 with his vehicle. It was determined that the brakes on Mr. Victoriano’s vehicle were not working. Mr. Victoriano will be required to pay for all damages caused by this accident.

We held a hearing for an unlicensed exercise rider for testing positive for Marijuana this morning. The subject was observed by Commission Inspectors while making their In-Today rounds exiting the shed row with smoking material. It was determined that subject had accessed the stable area on a day pass while bringing in several horses. Prior to applying for a DTRC license, subject was randomly drug tested with the positive results as previously indicated. The Stewards determined that the subject was ineligible for licensing and would have to successfully complete a substance abuse program prior to being considered in the future.
