Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Dr. Craig Goldblatt and Dr. Kathleen Picciano are the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarians.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Workout Sample #17649 from June 18, 2016 was cleared.
- All Samples from June 15, 2016 are cleared.
- Samples from June 16, 18, and 20, 2016 were cleared, with the exception of #17603, #17601, #17612, #17627, #17685, and #17694 from June 16th which were placed on hold. Sample #176184 from June 18th is still on hold. Samples #17719, #17722, and #17781 from June 20th were placed on hold.

We received a new report from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. that indicated the presence of “Glaucine” with the presence of other alkaloids in samples that were sent to the lab for testing. There are no ARCI guidelines on “Glaucine” positives. We conferred with the official laboratory, stewards and commissions in neighboring jurisdictions and presented that information to our legal counsel. Deputy Attorney General, Mr. Oliver Cleary drafted a notice of these findings indicating that when “Glaucine” is discovered with the presence of other alkaloids in the test sample it suggests that it was from an environmental source. Concerning the following samples, #16191 on June 13, 2016, #17534 on June 4, 2016, #17547 on June 4, 2016, #16135 on June 4, 2016, #17644 on June 8, 2016 and #17695 on June 11, 2016 that were placed on hold for “Glaucine” the Stewards will issue rulings releasing these samples, due to probable environmental contamination.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #1, “Howbouthemcowboys,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #7, “Majestic Doctor,” was a vet scratch. #1a, “Proudmiamicitizen,” ducked outward at the start.
ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 1a - 6.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. #3, “T Sizzle,” and #5, “I Came to Party,” were vet scratches. #6, “Holy Soldier,” was selected for a blood gas test.
INQUIRY IN MID STRETCH – The #6, “Holy Soldier,” broke down in mid-stretch in the left front. Following examination by Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano, “Holy Soldier” was humanely destroyed. Jockey Alex Cintron was assessed at first aid by EMT Kim Powers, who informed the Stewards that no injuries were noted or reported. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:20 p.m. #11, “Neutronstar,” was scratched as an alternate. #6, “Ashley’s Buzz,” was selected for a blood gas test.
