Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Three jockeys were randomly selected for testing today, all tests were clear.

Dr. Jane Teichner is the substitute Commission Veterinarian.

Administrative Hearings:

Movies were held today for the second race on Saturday, July 2, 2016. The movies concerned the run down the stretch where the #2, "Crimson Sunset," with jockey Brian Pedroza came in bumping and forcing the #6, "Luck's Honor," with jockey Ricardo Chiappe into bumping the #4, "Samara I Am," turning the #4 out into the #6. As a result of the video evidence, jockey Mr. Brian Pedroza will be issued a seven-day suspension for careless riding.

Movies were held today for the seventh race on Saturday, July 2, 2016. The movies concerned the run at the three-eighths pole where the #4, "Moly O'Shea," ridden by Carole Cedenno comes in a step where the #1, "Wilburn's Princess," and jockey Gary Wales comes out a step. Following the review, the Stewards decided to take no action due to the video evidence being inconclusive.

INQUIRY IN DEEP STRETCH. Hold and claim of foul by jockey Ricardo Chiappe of the #6, “Cryptic Kate,” against the #10, “Magic Ten,” ridden by Brian Pedroza. The claim of foul was in reference to the #10, “Magic Ten,” coming in down the stretch in front of the #6, “Cryptic Kate.” After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. Movies will be held for Mr. Ricardo Chiappe, and Mr. Brian Pedroza concerning this race on Wednesday, July 6, 2016. Eriluis Vaz, named on #11, “Money for Maria,” was changed to Gary Wales; no double jocks mount. #11, “Money for Maria,” was claimed by Jagger Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #11, “Money for Maria,” requested an all-inclusive special test. #4, “Sterlings Dolly,” was a trainer scratch.

Hold and claim of foul by jockey Brian Pedroza of the #3, “Inchargeofme (GB),” against the #8, “Relativism,” ridden by Gabriel Saez. The claim of foul was in reference to #8, “Relativism,” coming in shortly after the start causing Mr. Pedroza to check his mount. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards could see no reason to take any action and made the race official. Movies will be held for Mr. Brian Pedroza and Mr. Gabriel Saez concerning this race on Wednesday, July 6, 2016. #9, “Mood Swing,” was scratched as an alternate.
