Administrative Hearings:

Film reviews were held today for the sixth race for Wednesday, July 6, 2016. The video concerned the incident at the three eighths pole where the #7, "Locano," with jockey Marcelo Cardoso coming in forcing the #6, "Mizzentown," with jockey Katie Davis to check her horse. Following review of the video evidence, Mr. Marcelo Cardoso will be issued a seven day suspension for careless riding.

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. #5, "Next Right," was scratched by its trainer due to heat related issues. #6, "Casanova Way," was a vet scratch. A claim for the #9, "March Too," by L&K racing stable LLC – Gary Katz was "VOID" as the wrong date was entered on the claim blank, 6-7-2016 instead of 7-7 2016.

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #2, “S.S. Minnow,” was selected for a blood gas test.

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m.
INQUIRY IN MID STRETCH. Hold and claim of foul by jockey Trevor McCarthy rider of the #3, “La Murette,” against the #1, “Believe Indeed,” ridden by Daniel Centeno. The claim of foul was in reference to the #1, “Believe Indeed,” coming in down the stretch keeping the #3, “La Murette,” from coming out of the chute after it had gone into the chute on its own accord. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. #2, “Unforgivable Fire,” was a vet scratch. #1a, “Northern Eclipse,” #10, “Sally’s News,” #12, “Teufles and Roses,” and #13, “Bailey’s Island,” were scratched as alternates. #11, “Pound Sterling,” was scratched to re-enter. #1, “Believe Indeed,” was selected for a blood gas test.
