Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

A meeting was held at the direction of Mr. Wayne, DTRC Executive Director to review salix treatment protocols and examine the steps that led to the scratch of “Suffused” who was entered to run in the Grade III, ROBERT G. DICK MEMORIAL STAKES. “Suffused” was not administered its salix medication as required, which necessitated it being scratched. The meeting was attended by Mr. Wayne, Dr. Jay Baldwin, owner of First Equine which is the Commission’s third-party salix administration contractor, all of the Salix Treatment Vets, Acting Chief Commission Veterinarian, Susan Botts and Salix office supervisor, Beverly Fowler and her assistant, Kassi Hollick. The discussion began with Mr. Wayne emphasizing that racing is a sport of no mistakes and when they occur, there are financial consequences; financial consequences that impact horsemen, race track operations, the State and public. Such was the case in the “Suffused” scratch. A thorough examination of Salix administration protocols were reviewed and modified to prevent such mistakes from recurring.

We held a hearing this morning for Salix Vet, Robert Campbell, DVM for missing the treatment schedule for the horse, “Suffused (GB)” for assuming the horse was scratched and not verifying that information. A decision by the Stewards will be forthcoming concerning this matter.

We held a hearing with trainer Mr. Thomas Michaels Jr. concerning the condition of some of his horses.
