Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Dr. Craig Goldblatt is the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarian.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from June 30, 2016 were cleared.
- Samples #17733 and #17741 that were on hold from July 25, 2016 were cleared.
- Samples from July 2, 2016 were cleared with the exception of #17836 #17852 and #17864 which were placed on hold.
- Samples from July 4, 2016 were cleared with the exception of #17723 and #17726 which were placed on hold.
- Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #17768, taken from the horse "R B Nash" which ran in the 8th race on Thursday, June 23, 2016, contained "Phenylbutazone" in the amount of 11.09 micrograms of plasma. The trainer of record, Mr. Scott Powell, was informed of the laboratory findings by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector's Swift, Delaney, and Gowen, conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Powell's assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. Mr. Powell will be scheduled for a hearing concerning this matter.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, July 12 2016 for exercise rider Mr. Alexander Naupac. The hearing was for a vehicle accident in the parking lot at Delaware Park. As a result of the testimony of Mr. Naupac along with the video evidence supporting his testimony the Stewards issued no penalty for this accident. The insurance companies can try to determine fault.

Concerning the hearing held on Monday, July 11, 2016 for Salix Vet, Robert Campbell, DVM for missing the treatment schedule for the horse, "Suffused (GB)" and for assuming the horse was scratched and not verifying that information, the Stewards fined Dr. Campbell \$1000.00 for failure to treat the horse "Suffused (GB)" with Salix, necessitating a scratch. *(It is noted that Dr. Campbell was removed from the Salix rotation at Delaware Park)*

We held a meeting on Tuesday, July 12 2016 with all practicing Veterinarians at Delaware Park to explain the labeling practices and procedures for medications that are prescribed by them.

We held a hearing for practicing veterinarian Dr. Erika Beck for misplacing a loaded syringe and needle in the area of the receiving barn. As a result of the hearing Dr. Beck was issued a stern warning. If there are any future occurrences of this issue, a fine, suspension or both may be issued.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #5, "Chubby Charlie," was a vet scratch. #6, "Dreamed a Dream," was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #6, "Dreamed a Dream," stumbled at the start.
ORDER OF FINISH – "1 - 2 - 4 - 3." Starters - 5

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.
INQUIRY IN THE BACK -STRETCH. Hold and claim of foul by jockey Ricardo Chiappe of the #4, "Lady From Cheyenne," against the #5, "Ruby's Mine," ridden by Nick Juarez. The claim of foul was in reference to the #5, "Ruby's Mine," coming in down the back-stretch causing the #4, "Lady From Cheyenne," to check. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. #1a, "Mast Cove," was scratched as part of a same-owner entry.
ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 4 - 6 - 2." Starters – 9

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. The main track is now sealed starting with this race, due to steady rain. INQUIRY AT THE START - #2, “Viaggio,” stumbled at the start, causing apprentice jockey Kevin Gomez to lose his stirrups. Jockey Gomez put his feet back in the stirrups within a few strides. #1, “Eternal Tempest,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Sweet Yare N Dira,” was a vet scratch. ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 5 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 6

FIFTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. This race was taken off the turf at 2:58 due to steady rain. The main track is now labeled MUDDY. This race was scheduled at seven and one half furlongs on the turf, but ran at one mile on the main track. #5, “Summer Classic,” was a vet scratch. #13, “Captainly,” and #14, “Jalisco,” were scratched as alternates. #9, “Missy’s Heir,” was scratched as this race was taken off the turf, after the horse was blood gas tested. #9, “Missy’s Heir,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 7 - 6.” Starters - 10

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. #1, “Joan’s Delight,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Howboutthemcowboys,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 6

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. This race was taken off the turf at 2:58 due to steady rain. #6, “Snuggly Bear,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Unbridled Giant,” and #7, “I’m the Lucky One,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #8, “Flyingtobechilders,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 2 - 8.” Starters - 5

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:49 p.m. #1, “The Great Seven,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Jack Quickstart,” was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 5 - 9.” Starters - 8
