Administrative Hearings:

Movies were held today for the first race on Thursday, July 14, 2016. The movies concern the run into the first turn where the #3, "Don't Think Twice," with apprentice jockey Katie Davis allegedly came in forcing the #2, "Kearney Square," with jockey Scott Spieth to check his horse. As a result of the movies no action will be taken.

Movies were held today for the fourth race on Thursday, July 14, 2016. The movies concern the run at the three-eighths pole where the #6, "Purims's Gold," with jockey Carol Cedeno allegedly came in forcing the #5, "Corporate Measure," with apprentice jockey Kevin Mendez to check his horse. As a result of the movies no action will be taken.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #3, "Royal Brute," was scratched due to heat related conditions. #1, "Rumblin Kyle," was selected for a blood gas test.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #6, “Oneplayfullady,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Crimson Sunset.” stumbled and fell after the race pulling up, unseating apprentice jockey Katie Davis. Apprentice jockey Katie Davis was assessed at first aid by EMT Kim Powers, who informed the Stewards that no injuries were noted or reported.

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #3, “Kaiser’s d’Light,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Gin Makes Ya Sin,” was scratched as a main-track only.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #7, “War Academy,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Show Me the Way,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake, #8, “My Charming Clyde,” was claimed by Ridenjac Racing - Dennis Ward

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #1a, “Just Em,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Miss Green Pond,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Harley’s Joy,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Serenready,” was claimed by Bruno Schickedanz – Aldana Gonzalez. #8, “R Rousey,” was claimed by Take a Shot Stable LLC – Harold Wyner.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 9

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START - #3, “Digital Diva,” with rider Erick Rodriguez and #4, “Scat Arb,” with Carol Cedeno, both horses broke badly. The jockeys said the horses were at fault for not breaking well. Both horses were two-year old first time starters. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race the Stewards could see no reason to take any action and made the race official. #7, “Raja’s Legacy,” was selected for a blood gas test.

SEVENTH RACE – THE HOCKESSIN STAKES - POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. #3, “Rockinn On Bye,” #6, “Right Squall,” and #8, “Cooking Up a Storm,” were scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1.

NINTH RACE – THE DELAWARE HANDICAP (Grade I) - POST TIME – 5:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:26 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START. The Stewards did try to post the inquiry sign but the computer system did not take it. The inquiry was announced by the announcer. – No Hold was placed on this race with the outriders, but a claim of foul by Ricardo Santana Jr. the rider of the #1, “Paid Up Subscriber,” against Florent Geroux, the rider of the #4, “I’m a Chatterbox,” for coming in at the start forcing the #3 and #2 into the #1. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race the #4 does break in pushing the #3 and #2 into the #1. As a result of breaking in and the rider on the #4 having to take up and being behind the #1 at that point, along with the #1 never losing stride, the Stewards could see no reason to take any action and made the race official. All horses for this race were blood gas tested. (the incident of the inquiry malfunction was reported by the Stewards to Sportech Inc, the totalizator provider).

TENTH RACE – ON THE TURF – THE KENT STAKES (Grade III) - POST TIME – 5:59 p.m. OFF TIME – 6:03 p.m. #3, “Highly Prized (GB),” was scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. All horses for this race were blood gas tested.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 2 - 4.” Starters – 7

ELEVENTH RACE – THE CARL HANFORD MEMORIAL STAKES - POST TIME – 6:32 p.m. OFF TIME – 6:33 p.m. #6, “Warrioroftheroses,” was scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 7

TWELFTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 7:01 p.m. OFF TIME – 7:02 p.m. #4, “RB Open Fire,” and #5, “Lazur Hess,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.
