FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #7, “Kat Lion,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #6, “Think He’s Gone,” unseated its rider Diego Fernando Gomez following the race. Jockey Gomez was not injured as he landed on his feet and walked back to the winners circle. The #6 horse was caught by the outriders.

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m.
INQUIRY AT THE THREE-EIGHTHS POLE - #5, “She’satreehugger,” hit the rail approaching the three-eighths pole unseating jockey Augusto Marin who may have been hit by two trailing horses. Jockey Augusto Marin was transported to hospital for further evaluation. The Stewards could see no reason to take any action and made the race official. #3, “Sterling’s Bailesa,” was a vet scratch.
