Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing this morning with placing judges Ms. Roxanne Estrin and Mr. George Carey concerning the placings of the second and third horses in the first race on Wednesday, July 27 2016. As a result of the hearing, Ms. Estrin and Mr. Carey were issued written letters of reprimand by the Stewards under DTRC rules 3.3.2 and 4.7.

We held a hearing this morning concerning a protest by trainer Mr. Guy Smith as to the order of finish in the first race on Wednesday, July 27, 2016. Mr. Smith's protest was in reference to his horse "Willie Wears Pink" being placed third by the placing judges. The order of finish published by the placing judges was made official by the Stewards. First #7, Uncle Leo," second #4, "Willful Warrior," third #6, "Willie Wears Pink," and fourth #1, "Roundelay." After a hearing and review by the Stewards the order of finish will be revised for purse payouts only. First #7, Uncle Leo," second #6, "Willie Wears Pink," third #4, "Willful Warrior," and fourth #1, "Roundelay." The ruling in no way affects the pari-mutuel payoff for this race. *Delaware Park management indicated in a prior press release that they will honor any patron's tickets that were negatively affected by this mistakenly placed order of finish.*
