**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m.** #6, “Keep It Pithy,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Keep It Pithy,” broke inward at the start, and then was taken out to the middle of the track before coming back in. #1, “Perfect Wind,” was scratched by the Stewards, on the advice of Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, for being lame in the left front.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 5**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** #3, “Where’s Woody,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 5**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m.** Narciso Cruz, named on #1, “Looters Cache,” was changed to Juan Torres; no double jocks mount. #2, “Tipu Run,” and #6, “Wisdom of Solomon,” were vet scratches. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 4 – 1a.” Starters - 5**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m.** #1, “Perfect Rosie,” was scratched as a main-track only. #12, “Irish Sweetheart,” #13, “Hollywood Tomcat,” and #14, “I’m A Lucky Girl,” were scratched as alternates. #2, “Yonder Ponder,” was selected for a blood gas test. The saddle on the #3, “Blunts Ridge,” with rider Diego Fernando Gomez slipped forward on the horse. We called the rider and he confirmed what the Stewards had observed. We also contacted the outrider asking what happened and he said the saddle had slipped forward. The valet said the over girth had slid backward.

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m.** #3, “Perfect Prediction,” was scratched by the racing office. #4, “Viaggio,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Love in Tokyo,” was scratched as a main-track only. #13, “Notapradaprice,” and #14, “Diana’s Thrill,” were scratched as alternates. #8, “Lucky in Malibu,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**SEVENTH RACE – THE STRIKE YOUR COLORS STAKES - POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m.** #7, “Blue Moon Runner,” was scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #6, “Greatbullsoffire,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 6**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START AND INTO THE FIRST TURN** – Hold and claim of foul by Ricardo Chiappe the rider of the #4, “Justforgetaboutit,” against the #6, “Don’t Think Twice,” and rider Katie Davis for coming over on him going into the turn causing him to check his horse. It looked like the #4 was getting out bumping and turning the #6 in. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. Movies will be held for Mr. Ricardo Chiappe, and Ms. Katie Davis concerning this race on Saturday, August 6, 2016. The #1a, “Lifes Reward,” dwelt at the start breaking slowly. #1, “Royal Knowledge,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Genteel Citizen,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Prime Number,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1a, “Lifes Reward,” was claimed by Mike Catalano Jr. – Randy Allen. A claim in for the #1a, “Lifes Reward,” by Steve and Allison Hassig – Allison Hassig was **VOID** due to a lack of money in the partnership account.
