Administrative Hearings:

Apprentice Jockey, Mr. Silvestre Gonzalez, who had tested positive for marijuana on Tuesday, July, 26, 2016, was reinstated with a conditional license, upon recommendation from the horsemen's Drug and Alcohol counselor Ms. Nan Freeman. Mr. Gonzalez must comply with all conditions set forth in the ruling issued by the Stewards.

We had a hearing scheduled on Tuesday, August 9, 2016 for trainer Mr. Mario Serey, for failure to run the horse "Go Bo Go," entered at Delaware Park in the 6th race on Wednesday, August 3, 2016. Mr. Serey failed to show for the hearing. Consequently, his actions were deemed to be in violation of Commission rules 3.4, 3.4.1 3.4.1.7 and 11.14.1.3, and was suspended pending his appearance before the stewards.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:15 p.m. #1, "Roundelay," was a vet scratch. #6, "Fifteen Black," was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 7 - 4 - 6." Starters - 7

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. #6, "Synchronous," was a vet scratch. The #3, "Two Term Leader," was a late scratch by the Stewards as he unseated jockey Trevor McCarthy during the post parade and ran off almost a mile before being caught by the outriders. **INQUIRY AT THE START - #2,"Shordawatyadrink,"** with rider Ashley Castrenze reared up as the gates opened breaking slowly and was pulled up shortly after the start. #1, "Strongbacksteltoes," was claimed by Phillip Leary – William Sienkewicz. Jockeys McCarthy and Castrenze were assessed at first aid by EMT Kim Powers, who informed the Stewards that no injuries were noted or reported.
