Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from July 27, 2016 were cleared including #17812 and #18375 which had been previously placed on hold.

Administrative Hearings:

A hearing was held today for trainer Mr. Mario Seary, for failure to run the horse “Go Bo Go,” entered at Delaware Park in the 6th race on Wednesday, August 3, 2016. Consequently, as a result of his actions which were deemed in violation of Commission rules 3.4, 3.4.1 3.4.1.7 and 11.14.1.3, Mr. Seary was fined the amount of \$100.00 and will be reinstated from his suspension for failure to show for his scheduled hearing. Mr. Seary will not be penalized for failure to run the horse, as the papers and coggins test were misplaced by the racing office at Parx Racing.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE THREE EIGHTHS POLE. - Hold and claim of foul by jockey Gabriel Saez of the #5, “Trousseau,” against the #8, “Northern Mine,” ridden by Trevor McCarthy. The claim of foul was in reference to the #8, “Northern Mine,” coming in at the three-eighths pole causing the #5, to check his horse. During review of the films it appeared that the #8 had kept a straight course with the #4 getting out forcing the #5 out behind the #8. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race the Stewards determined that no action was appropriate and made the race official. A claim in for #2, “Explosive Candy,” by Thomas L. Reynolds – Scott Lake was **VOID** as the owner’s last name was misspelled “Reynold” instead of “Reynolds.”
