



## Daily Log Stewards Report Delaware Park

Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

### **Administrative:**

The Stewards attended the Delaware Racing Commission meeting this morning at 10:05 a.m.

Dr. Craig Goldblatt is the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarian.

### **Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:**

- All out of competition samples from August 5, 6, and 7, 2016 were cleared.
- All samples from August 4, and 8, 2016 were cleared.
- Sample #18003 from, August 6, 2016, was placed on hold.

### **Administrative Hearings:**

• Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #18429, taken from the horse “Harley’s Joy,” which ran in the 9th race on Monday, August 1, 2016, contained “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 0.200 micrograms per milliliter of plasma, and “Flunixin” in the amount of 42 nanograms per milliliter of plasma, The trainer of record, Ms. Sandra Kite, was informed of the laboratory findings by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift, and Gowen, conducted a barn inspection of trainer Kite’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. Ms. Kite waived her right to a split sample, and a hearing in this matter accepting the penalty of a fifteen day suspension and a five hundred dollar fine, along with the horse “Harley’s Joy” having to pass a veterinarian inspection and blood test. The blood test will have to be returned clear before the horse can be entered to race.

Video reviews were held today for the first race on Monday, August 15, 2016. The videos concerned the run at the five-eighths pole and the sixteenth pole where the #3, “Arch’s Cutie,” with jockey Carol Cedeno comes in at both points shutting off the #2, “Southern

Christmas,” and jockey Ricardo Chiappe. As a result of the evidence in the films, jockey Cedeno will be suspended seven calendar days for careless riding.

**THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m.** Scott Spieth, named on #4, “Missy’s Heir,” was changed to Katie Davis; no double jocks mount. #1, “Love the Beat,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #13, “Fast Flying Fred,” and #14, “Smart Two a T,” were scratched as alternates. #5, “Osceola Pond,” was claimed by Juan Arriagada – Allison Hassig. The #8, “Spider John,” broke in at the start, pushing the #7, #6, and #5, inward. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 10 - 2 - 8.” Starters - 11**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:51 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH- Hold and claim of foul.** The #2, “Tiffany’s Treasure,” ridden by Carol Cedeno and the #9, “She’satoughbroad,” with rider Jose Ferrer claimed foul against the #4, “Bustin Gold,” with rider Diego Fernando Gomez for coming in down the stretch, shutting off the #9 and the #2, causing them to check their horses and alter course.. After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the riders involved the Stewards disqualified the #4 from first and placed her third behind the #2 who was moved up to first and the #9 who was moved up to second. Jockeys Carol Cedeno, Diego Fernando Gomez and Jose Ferrer are required to attend the film review for this race on Thursday, August 18, 2016.
