Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

Racing video reviews were held today for the fourth race on Wednesday, August 17, 2016. The video concerned the run down the stretch where the #4, “Bustin Gold,” with jockey Diego Gomez came in shutting off the #2, “Tiffany’s Treasure,” ridden by Carol Cedeno and the #9, “She’satoughbroad,” with jockey Jose Ferrer, making both horses check and alter course. As a result of the movies jockey Mr. Diego Gomez will be suspended seven calendar days for careless riding.

We held a hearing today with exercise rider Mr. Keith Sargent for an altercation in a dorm room, with veterinarian technician Ms. Reva Iardi. As a result of the hearing Mr. Sargent, is fined the sum of \$500.00. Mr. Sargent will be placed on a conditional license and be required to attend and complete an anger management program approved by the Stewards by October 17, 2016. *(An order of protection was filed against Mr. Sargent was enforced by the Delaware Park security. Subsequently, Sargent who is to have no contact with the victim was evicted in accordance with that court order).*

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #6, “Super Chica,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY IN THE FIRST TURN. - Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Brian Pedroza of the #1, “I’m Not Joking,” against the #4, “Whatifiwaswilling,” ridden by Gabriel Saez. The claim of foul was in reference to the #4, “Whatifiwaswilling,” dropping in too fast going into the first turn causing the #1 to check. Review of the video revealed that the #4 came in, but left room for the # 1 and was well clear. The #1 started getting out when the rider took hold of the horse. After talking to the riders involved and previously reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that no action was warranted and made the race official. #5, “Ruthenium,”

was selected for a blood gas test. #4, "Whatifiwaswilling," was claimed by Trigger Racing – Edward Lotruglio.

ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 1 - 3 - 7." Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #3, "I Wanda Win," was a vet scratch. #6, "Lucky Rascal," was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. Erasmo Martinez, named on #6, "Gitanilla," was changed to Kevin Gomez; no double jocks mount.

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:50 p.m. Scott Spieth, named on #1, "Melody Pomeroy," was changed to Travis Wales; no double jocks mount. #2, "Q's Jack," was a vet scratch.

ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 7 - 1 - 6." Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #7, "Arcani," was a vet scratch. #8, "Purim's Gold," was scratched by the racing office to re-enter.

ORDER OF FINISH – "2 - 9 - 4 - 1." Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. Scott Spieth, named on #3, "Gemsum," was changed to Erick Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. Jose Caraballo, named on #9, "Musical Journey," was changed to Cecily Evans; no double jocks mount. #5, "On Your Mach," and #10, "Newport Red," were vet scratches. #7, "Fifth Avenue Flash," was scratched as a main-track only. #12, "We Miss Anthony," was scratched as an alternate. #13, "Tampa Bay Blue," was scratched to re-enter. #9, "Musical Journey," was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – "1 - 9 - 4 - 11." Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. Scott Spieth, named on #5, "River of Magic," was changed to Erick Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. David Lopez, named on #6, "Sir Sidney," was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; Mr. Lopez suffered from heat related problems after the fifth race and was examined by the EMT'S. No double jocks mount. #3, "Snuggly Bear," #4, "Stolen Love," and #10, "Yolo Mon," were vet scratches. #7, "Hauler," was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – "1 - 2 - 6 - 8." Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. #6, "Understanding," and #8, "Brazilian Symphony," were scratched as a main-track only.

ORDER OF FINISH – "7 - 10 - 4 - 1." Starters - 8

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:19 p.m. Kevin Mendez, named on #3, “Waterford Crystal,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. Marcelo Cardoso, named on #4, “Zarifa CS,” was changed to Ruben Silvera; no double jocks mount. #8, “Last Call MHF,” was selected for a blood gas test. #8, “Last Call MHF,” was eased in the stretch at the 1/16 pole. Jockey Chiappe as a precaution, dismounted the horse and stated that he thought the horse had broken down. Dr. Brown examined the horse and reported that in his opinion the horse ambulance was not necessary. Subsequently, the “Last Call MHF” walked off of the racing surface under its own power.
