



Daily Log Stewards Report Delaware Park

Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Dr. Craig Goldblatt is the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarian.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from August 6, 2016 were cleared including sample #18003 which had been previously placed on hold.
- All out of competition samples thus far from August 2016 were cleared.
- Samples from August 11, 2016 were cleared with the exception of #18453, which was placed on hold.
- Samples from August 15, 2016 were cleared with the exception of #18214, and #18366 which were placed on hold.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, August 23, 2016 for trainer Mr. Gregory Sacco concerning his entering the horse "Theyallcomehome" at two different tracks within the five-day entry period. It was noted that Mr. Sacco ran this horse at Monmouth Park on July 30th while it was also entered in the 2nd race at Delaware on August 1st which was later scratched. Consequently, Mr. Sacco's actions were deemed in violation of Commission rules 3.4, 3.4.1.15 and 11.2.12, and was assessed a fine of \$1,000.00.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Real Power,” was scratched by its trainer, as the horse transportation had broken down. #4, “Two is to Many,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Brothersofthetime,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for his race as we were below six betting interests. #2, “El Oh El,” was claimed by Drawing Away Stable – Wayne Potts. After a three-way shake, #7, “Bothersofthetime,” was claimed by Home Team Stable – Scott Lake.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 5

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Mohamed Osman, named on #5, “Dangerous Vixen,” was changed to Corey Mongan; double jocks mount will be charged. #2, “Jennie Says So,” was scratched by its trainer, as the horse transportation had broken down. #8, “Spanish Dream,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 7

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. - Hold and claim of foul by jockey Ashley Castrenze of the #4, “Game Winning Shot,” against the #7, “Regere,” ridden by Ricardo Chiappe. The claim of foul was in reference to the #7, for coming in during the stretch run causing the #4 to check her horse. It looked like the #7 came in but left room for the #4 until clear while pulling away. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. Video review will be held for this race on Thursday, August 25, 2016. #1a, “One Step Closer,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry.

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:22 p.m. #11, “Where’s the Risk,” was a vet scratch. #12, “Jazz Band Joe,” was scratched as a main-track only. #13, “Summer’s Here,” was scratched as an alternate. #9, “Frequently,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 – (2-3) Dead Heat - 7.” Starters - 10

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:54 p.m. #1, “Rumblin Kyle,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 10 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 9

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m. #1, “River Running,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #8, “Blyde River,” was a vet scratch. #10, “Daftar,” and #12, “Molasses Brown,” were scratched as alternates. #9, “City Traveler,” was selected for a blood gas test.
