Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Dr. Craig Goldblatt is the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarian.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from August 11, 2016 were cleared including #18453, which had been previously placed on hold.
- All Samples from August 15, 2016 were cleared including #18214, and #18366 which had been placed on hold.
- Sample #17611 from August 17, 2016 was cleared.

Administrative Hearings:

A video review session was held for the third race on Wednesday, August 24, 2016 today. The review concerned the run down the stretch where the #7, "Regere," ridden by Ricardo Chiappe allegedly comes in forcing the #4, "Game Winning Shot," ridden by Ashley Castrenze to check her mount. As a result of the evidence in the videos, no action will be taken.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Mohamed Osman, named on #2, "Residual Value," was changed to Travis Wales; double jocks mount will be charged. #3, "Westbrook Sunset," #6, "Starship Stache," #10, "Lady Aconite," and #13, "Michelle," were scratched by the racing office to re-enter.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. - Hold and claim of foul by jockey Trevor McCarthy of the #1, “Lifes Reward,” against the #10, “Whisky Sour,” ridden by Daniel Centeno. The claim of foul was in reference to the #10, for getting out during the stretch run bumping the #1. Video showed that the #1 came in causing the bumping of #10 instead of the #10 coming out. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the video of the race the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. A claim in for the #1, “Life’s Reward,” by Jagger Inc. & Run To Win Stable was **VOID** for lack for money for the claim in their joint horseman’s account.

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:54 p.m. Jose Betancourt, named on #7, “Mark On the Run,” was changed to Mohamed Osman; no double jocks mount. #10, “Patrolikeachampion,” was scratched as a main-track only. #1a, “Chief Redneck,” #11, “Sounds of Saratoga,” #12, “Corinthian Summer,” and #13, “Brilliant Warrior,” were scratched as alternates. #1, “I Heart Junior,” was scratched by the Stewards upon the advice of Associate Commission veterinarian Dr. Richard Brown, for not warming up well during the post parade.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:24 p.m. Mohamed Osman, named on #5, “Private Biggs,” was changed to Travis Wales; double jocks mount will be charged. #1, “Blitzensmajikreign,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Casanova Way,” was selected for a blood gas test. #10, “Imslopokerodriguez,” was claimed by Juan Arriagada – Allison Hassig.

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m. #1, “Sea Treaty,” and #2, “Seventy Niner,” were scratched as parts of same-owner entries. #7, “Sierra Sun,” was scratched by its trainer.
ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 3 - 8 - 10.” Starters -10

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:52 p.m.
INQUIRY AT THE THREE- EIGHTHS POLE – The hoofs of #7, “Valueable Charmer,” slid out from under her and then lost its action in the hind end unseating rider Erick Rodriguez. The #3, “Isabella Swift,” then unseated rider Maria Remedio, while trying to avoid the fallen horse and rider. Jockey Remedio was transported to hospital for further evaluation. Jockey Erick Rodriguez was assessed at first aid by EMT Kim Powers, who informed the Stewards that no injuries were noted or reported. #10, “Street Cruizer,” was scratched as an alternate. #5, “Mizz Martha,” was selected for a blood gas test.
ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 2 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 9
