Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

### Administrative:

Dr. Lyndsy Castano is the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarian.

Four assistant starters were randomly selected for testing today. All tests were negative.

### Administrative Hearings:

Jockeys Scott Spieth, Daniel Centeno, and all apprentice riders were required to attend the video review today at 12:00 noon. The videos concerned a claim of foul by Mr. Spieth, against Mr. Centeno at the top of the stretch during the 6<sup>th</sup> race on Saturday, August 27, 2016. Following the review and discussion, no action was deemed necessary.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.** #3, “My Charming Clyde,” was claimed by Runnin Shoes Stable – Kimberly Graci. #7, “Seve,” was claimed by Thomas Reynolds – Scott Lake. A claim in for the #3, “My Charming Clyde,” by Jorge Diaz was **VOID** as Mr. Diaz has not previously started a horse in his name during the current meeting. #5, “Horatio,” was selected for a Stewards special test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** #3, “Lucky Rascal,” and #6, “Manando,” were vet scratches. #8, “Ghostbuster,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 8 - 4.” Starters – 6**

**THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.**  
Keiber Coa, named on #5, “Mangrove Pond,” was changed to Carol Ceden0; no double jocks mount. #2, “Fifteen Black,” was scratched by its trainer. #11, “Luigi P,” was scratched as an alternate. #1 “Next Right,” broke slow as he turned his head just as the race started.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 8 - 4 - 10.” Starters - 9**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m.** #8, “All Aboutthe Salsa,” was selected for a blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 8**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m.** Alex Cintron, named on #5, “Bird Call,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #12, “Sully Man,” #13, “Invisible Crown,” and #14, “One Eyed Ray,” were scratched as alternates. **INQUIRY IN MID STRETCH –** The #6, “Whippo,” with rider Andrew Wolfson ducked inward in mid-stretch causing the #2, ridden by Daniel Centeno to check his mount. No action was taken as the #2 had beaten the #6.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 8 - 4.” Starters - 11**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m.** #8, “Vibrant Ginger,” was selected for a blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 8**

**SEVENTH RACE (2 Yr-Olds) – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m.** #9, “Honorable Service,” was a vet scratch. #1a, “Brahms Secret,” #10, “Bridge Builder,” and #11, “He’s Cheeky,” were scratched as alternates. The #3, “Hot and Heavy,” got loose in the paddock and ran onto the main track before being caught by the outriders. The Stewards scratched the #2, “What Gives,” after it unseated jockey Ashley Castrenze during the post parade and ran off for approximately three-quarters of a mile before being caught by the outriders. Jockey Ashley Castrenze was not injured in the mishap. During the race: **INQUIRY IN THE FIRST TURN -** #7, “Pahall Reveal,” unseated rider Katie Davis in the first turn. It appeared that the #12 came in slightly and when the rider of the #7 took hold of her horse, the horse went straight instead of making the turn and clipped heels of the #12, unseating Ms. Davis. After reviewing the video the Stewards did not take any action and made the race official. Jockey Katie Davis was transported to hospital for further evaluation.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 3 - 12.” Starters - 8**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:52 p.m.** #1, “Dan’s Girl,” and #5, “Key to The Highway,” were vet scratches. #8, “Fortutious,” was selected for a blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 6**
