Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All samples from August 18, 20, and 22, 2016 were cleared.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #6, “Love the Beat,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #3, “Cowboys Lucky Lady,” and #6, “Sunshineinmypocket,” were vet scratches.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 8 - 5.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. #12, “Deference,” and #13, “Kellyesque,” were scratched as alternates.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 3 - 1.” Starters -11

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. Ashley Castrenze, the rider of the #2, “Summer in Seattle,” claimed foul against the #3, “J Be K’s Sonnet ridden by Ricardo Chiappe and #5, “Hurricane Raven,” ridden by Nicholas Petro, for coming in at the three-sixteenths pole and taking her room away, causing her to check her mount. The claim of foul was lodged after returning to the unsaddling area and talking to the trainer of the horse. No inquiry by the Stewards nor hold by the rider was lodged in this race. After reviewing the video of the race the Stewards deemed that no action was warranted and made the race official. #6, “L X Sunrise,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 9 - 6.” Starters - 9

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. An insert had to be printed for the program concerning the second page for this race. The second page of four horses concerning the #5 through the #8 had to be added, as the print shop inserted the second page of the fourth race instead of the sixth race. Katie Davis, named on #7, “That’s Cool Man,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 3 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. #6, “Why Not Be Sexy,” and #10, “Sea View Millie,” were scratched as main-track only. #12, “Head for the Hills,” was scratched as an alternate.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 11 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 9

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. #1, “Champion Rose,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Secret Garden,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:17 p.m. #6, “Ruthenium,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
