Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 6, 2016 for trainer Ms. Lori Smock concerning failure to have workman's compensation that covered her employees as well as her. Consequently, Ms. Smock as result of her actions which were deemed in violation of Commission rules 3.3, 3.4, 3.4.1, 3.4.1.7 and 7.3.3, Ms. Smock was fined the sum of \$250.00 and required to update her workman's compensation policy. Ms. Smock was also ordered to pay all medical expenses and salary on an injured employee, until released to return to work.

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. - Hold and claim of foul by jockey Trevor McCarthy rider of the #9, “Backside Affair,” against the #2, “Kissthebutterflies,” ridden by Ashley Castrenze. The claim of foul was in reference to the #2, allegedly coming in during the stretch run into the chute on the turf course causing the rider of the #9, to check his horse. Video review revealed that the #9 went into the chute before the #2 came in and then tried to force his way back out but had to check his horse as the #2 did not move out far enough because of horses on the outside of her. After interviewing the riders involved and based on the video evidence, the Stewards determined that no action was necessary and made the race official. Francisco Maysonett, named on #1, “Basic Training,” was changed to Jose Caraballo; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Beach Tag,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #10, “Crystals Gotagun,” was scratched as a main-track only. #8, “Flaming Embers,” was selected for a blood gas test.
