Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Dr. Kristen Pastir and Dr. Craig Goldblatt are the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarians.

Administrative Hearings:

Today we held a hearing for grooms Mr. Javier Garcia and Mr. Jacob Hooks who both tested positive for Marijuana. As a result of the hearing Garcia and Hooks were suspended pending evaluation and recommendation from the horsemen's Drug and Alcohol counselor. The counselor Ms. Nan Bernardo M.S.C.C. must send the Stewards a written evaluation and recommendation, along with a negative test result before a reinstatement hearing will be considered for the subjects.

Exercise Rider, Mr. Antonio Sandoval was present before the Board of Stewards for a hearing in reference to his drug positive for Marijuana. It was determined that this was Mr. Sandoval's second offense. Consistent with DTRC Rules and Regulations, Mr. Sandoval was suspended for a period of six (6) months and required to attend and complete a Substance Abuse Program approved by the Stewards. Mr. Sandoval will be required to submit proof of the program completion and a written evaluation submitted by the substance abuse counselor along with a negative test result before a reinstatement hearing will be considered.

Jose Flores, named on #6, “Dilly Dedalus,” was changed to Ever Argueta; no double jocks mount. #1, “Shar Shar, (IRE),” was scratched by its trainer due to heat related conditions. #8, “Street Play,” was claimed by Robert D. Bone – Thomas Clark.

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:14 p.m. #1, “Senor Quickie,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #1a, “Seventy Niner,” and #6, “Steve Came Thru,” were vet scratches. #2, “Start Jumping,” was scratched by the Stewards as the horse was determined to be ineligible. #7, “Heady Creek,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.
ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 4

EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:46 p.m. #10, “Soigne,” was scratched as a main-track only. #11, “Eleusis (GB),” and #12, “Night Madam,” were scratched as alternates. #1, “My Awsome Alie,” was selected for a Stewards special test. #9, “Just My Game,” was selected for a blood gas test. The rider on the #1, “My Awsome Alie,” Taylor Hole lost his right stirrup shortly after the start, and then kicked his foot out of the left stirrup. The Stewards spoke with Mr. Hole who stated that the buckle on the stirrup leather had unbuckled two jumps out of the gate, so he took his left foot out, as he could not use the right stirrup.
