**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:15 p.m.** #1a, “Allied Kid,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Dreamingoffirst,” was scratched due to heat related conditions. #4, “M B Prize,” and #7, “Avery’s Parade,” were vet scratches. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m.** #5, “Celtic Moon,” and #6, “Alluseeismytale,” were scratched by its trainer due to heat related conditions. #2, “Hurler,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Curlin’s Kid,” was claimed by Ross Santangelo – Brett Santangelo.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 8 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**SIXTH RACE – THE NEW CASTLE - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. - Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Jose Caraballo of the #1, “Final Prospect,” against the #2, “Cinco Charlie,” ridden by Ricardo Santana Jr. The claim of foul was in reference to the #2, coming in during the stretch run bumping the #1 and causing that rider him to check his horse. After interviewing the riders involved and based on video evidence, the Stewards disqualified the #2, from second and placed him third behind the #1 who was moved up to second from third. Jockeys Jose Caraballo and Ricardo Santana Jr. are required to attend the film review for this race on Monday, September 12, 2016. #4, “Silver Trophy,” was scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 4**

**SEVENTH RACE – THE FIRST STATE DASH - POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m.** #1a, “Roethlisberger,” and #7, “Josey Wales,” were scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #1, “Gaetano,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 6**

**EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:45 p.m.** Luis Garcia, named on #4, “Giles Fair,” was changed to Erick Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. #9, “Space Key,” and #10, “Ardacious,” were vet scratches. #7, “Giza,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**NINTH RACE – THE TAX FREE SHOPPING DISTAFF - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:16 p.m.** #2, “Outwithbigdaddy,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #3, “Galiana,” pulled up at the three-sixteenths pole with the rider Abel Lezcano jumping off in the stretch trying to hold onto the horse. The horse got loose from the rider and was caught by the groom just before the finish line. Chief Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts examined the horse stating that the horse looked like it had re-bowed. Dr. Botts called the horse ambulance to transport the horse from the racing surface and return it to its barn.
