Administrative Hearings:

A film review was held today for the sixth race on Saturday, September 10, 2016. The review concerned the run down the stretch. The #2, "Cinco Charlie," ridden by Ricardo Santana Jr. came in during the stretch run shutting off and bumping the #1, "Final Prospect," ridden by Jose Caraballo. Due to the video evidence the Stewards will issue a seven day suspension to Ricardo Santana Jr. for careless riding.

We held a hearing this morning with assistant starters Mr. Wayne Sargent and Mr. Carlos Diaz concerning wagering on races while in the employees lunch room. As a result of the hearing Mr. Sargent and Mr. Diaz were issued written letters of reprimand by the Stewards under DTRC rules 3.3, 3.4, 3.4.1.7, 4.1.2.1, 4.1.2.2 and 4.5.1.4.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, "Fleetwood Star,"
was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 5 - 6 - 1." Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #5, "Keypartner,"
was a vet scratch.

ORDER OF FINISH – "3 - 2 - 1 - 4." Starters – 6

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF – LONGINES INTERNATIONAL GENTLEMAN FEGENTRI - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #3, “Prime Number,” and #6, “Uncle Harry,” were vet scratches. #7, “Hard Drive,” was selected for a blood gas test. The riders on the #7, “Hard Drive,” and #12, “Dominick’s Smile,” both broke on the horse’s mouth causing them to throw their heads up breaking slowly. The saddle slipped back on the #11, “Original Cast,” who was caught by the outriders after pulling up.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 10

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. #7, “Go Bo Go,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Big Silver Hoss,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – 5 - 6 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 6

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:14 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #6, “Roethlisberger,” was eased at the quarter-pole; the rider did ride the horse back to be unsaddled.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 10 – 2 - 4.” Starters - 10

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. #8, “Willie Wears Pink,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 4 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 10

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:20 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. - Hold and claim of foul by jockey Jevian Toledo of the #1, “Stormy Mistress,” against the #8, “Hidden Pearl,” ridden by Jesus Bracho. The claim of foul was in reference to the #8, coming out during the stretch run brushing and intimidating the #1, causing him to check his horse. After interviewing the riders involved and based on video evidence, the Stewards disqualified the #8, from first and placed him second behind the #8 who was moved up to first from second. Jockeys Jesus Bracho, and Jevian Toledo are required to attend the film review for this race on Wednesday, September 14, 2016.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 12

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:56 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. - Hold and claim of foul by jockey Scott Spieth rider of #2, “Josey Wales,” against the #1, “Confederate,” ridden by Alex Cintron. The claim of foul was in reference to the #1 coming in during the stretch run bumping the #2. The #2 came out also bumping with the #1. After interviewing the riders involved and based on video evidence, the Stewards determined that no action was necessary and made the race official. Jockeys Alex Cintron, and Scott Spieth are required to attend the film review for this race on Wednesday, September 14, 2016. The #7, “What Gives,” started bucking shortly after the start unseating jockey Forest Boyce. The jockey Ms. Boyce was checked by the ambulance EMTS, who informed the Stewards the rider was not injured after being unseated. #4, “Mister Henry Lee,” was scratched by the Stewards as the horse is on the bleeders list at Monmouth Park.
