



# Daily Log Stewards Report Delaware Park

Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

## **Administrative:**

Dr. Kristen Pastir is the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarian.

## **Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:**

- Samples from September, 15, 17, and 19, 2016 were cleared, with the exception of #18263 and #18281 from September 15, and #18234 and #18276 from September 19, which were placed on hold.

## **Administrative Hearings:**

- On September 27, 2016 we held a hearing for unlicensed trainer Ms. Kathy Barraclough concerning her entering the horse “Ardacious” at two different tracks within the five-day entry period. Consequently, Ms. Barraclough scratched her horse from the 8th race at Delaware Park on 9-10 -16 running the horse at Parx Racing on Sunday, Sunday, September 11, 2016. As a result of her actions which were deemed in violation of Commission rules 3.4, 3.4.1.15 and 11.2.12, Ms. Barraclough was fined the sum of \$1,000.00.
- We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 27, 2016 for exercise rider Mr. Cesar Montenegro for his involvement with the theft of money from a patron by Jason Forde. Mr. Montenegro had been suspended for failure to show as at a scheduled hearing. As a result of the 9-27-16 hearing, Mr. Montenegro was fined the sum of \$100.00 for failure to show for the previously scheduled hearing and was also ordered to pay an additional fine of \$100. Mr. Montenegro was reinstated to good standing after paying both fines.
- During a hearing on September 27, 2016, Owner - Trainer Jonathan Maldonado was cited for failure to have a proper bill of sale and transfer from the Stewards on the horse “SUPERMENSCH” prior to the 5<sup>th</sup> race on September 12, 2016. Maldonado’s actions were deemed in violation of Commission rules 2.5.1.3, 3.3, 3.3.6, 3.4 and 3.4.1.7, for failure to conduct his business in a proper manner, and for failure to have a bill of sale. Trainer Maldonado was fined the sum of \$500.00 for this rule violation. An agreement between Michael Dubb and

Trainer Maldonado took place on the disposition of purse money earned by “SUPERMENSCH” from the 5<sup>th</sup> Race on September 12, 2016.

• Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #17954, taken from the horse “Big Silver Hoss” which won the 4th race on September 12, 2016, contained “Levamisole.” The trainer of record, Mr. Gerald Bennett, was informed of the laboratory findings by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift, and Delaney, conducted a barn inspection of trainer Bennett’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items, but did reveal 5 containers of de-worming paste that contained “Levamisole.” Mr. Bennett waived his right to a split sample and formal hearing in this matter and accepted the penalty of a fifteen day suspension and a five hundred dollar fine. In addition, the horse, “BIG SILVER HOSS” was disqualified from the race on 9-12-16 and the forfeited purse money. Under the Multiple Medication Violation System, Trainer Bennett also received 4 points for the positive test.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.** Jonathan Zayas, named on #1, “Super Duker,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #6, “Ruthieobberah,” and #11, “Wind Clan Warrior,” were vet scratches. 9, “Conceited Saint,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Ocala Rush,” pulled up lame following the race and was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. The rider of the #7, Jose Lopez, dismounted and unsaddled the horse while it was being held by the outrider.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 9**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** #6, “Subtle Intent,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Con Gee,” was claimed by Home Team Stables – Scott Lake. #6, “Subtle Intent,” was eased to the wire, by jockey Ricardo Chiappe, who reported the horse was off and not feeling right. No infirmities were noted by the Stewards or Commission Veterinarian and the horse walked off of the racing surface under its own power.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.** The main track has been sealed and downgraded to **GOOD** starting with this race. #7, “Unique Greatness,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Harley’s Joy,” was claimed by Positive Connection Stable –Harold Wyner.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 8 - 9 - 2.” Starters - 9**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.** #3, “Panchanga Party,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Able Baker Charlie,” broke slowly.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m.** The turf course has been downgraded to **YIELDING** starting with this race. #1, “Angelic Faith,” was scratched by its trainer. #5, “Code Name Raven,” was scratched as a main-track only. After a two-way shake, #8, “Caldera,” was claimed by Prosperity LLC – Brett Santangelo.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 2 - 9 - 4.” Starters - 10**

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m.** The Main track has been sealed and downgraded to **MUDDY** starting this race. #4, “Port Aggregate,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Judge Carr,” was selected for a blood gas test. #2, “Street Spice,” was claimed by Run To Win Stable & Jagger Inc. - Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #2, “Street Spice,” requested an all-inclusive special test. After a two-way shake, #7, “You’re No Saint,” was claimed by Patrick Sullivan & J. R. Boesen – Ray E. Tracy Jr.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 7 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:49 p.m.** #7, “Lake Sebago,” was scratched by its trainer. #10, “Ritzy Class,” was scratched as a main-track only. #8, “Taller Sister,” was selected for a blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 8**

**NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:20 p.m.** #2, “Play Me Now,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Fifteen Black,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a three-way shake, #1, “In Condition,” was claimed by Nations Racing Stable – Keith Nations. A claim in for the #1, “In Condition,” by The Hawkin Stable – Juan Palanco was Void as the horse’s name that had started here was misspelled.
