Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All samples from September, 15, 17, 19, and 21, 2016 were cleared.
- Samples from September, 22, 24, and 26, 2016 were cleared, with the following exceptions: #18034, #18085 and #18206, from September 22, #18369 from September 24 and #18378 from September 26, which were placed on hold.
- Workout samples #18190, and #18379 from September 27, 2016, were cleared.
