Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Dr. Craig Goldblatt is the substitute Associate Commission Veterinarian.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Samples #18034, #18085 and #18206, for September 22, #18369, on September 24, and #18378 on September 26 that were previously placed on hold, were cleared.
- All samples from October 1, and 3, 2016 were cleared.
- Workout samples #17969, from October 2, and #18812 from October 3, 2016, were cleared.
- All out of competition samples taken for October 2016, were cleared. A total of 39 trainers with 195 horses were tested under the Out of Competition Program for 2016 racing season.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, October 12, with Pony Boy Shane Sonnier who was summarily suspended on 10-8-16 for disorderly conduct, use of profanity in public and refusal to submit to a drug test. As a result of the hearing Mr. Sonnier was fined the sum of \$100.00. Mr. Sonnier was also required to attend and complete a drug and alcohol and anger management program approved by the Stewards before being considered for reinstatement.

Trainer Mario Serey waived his right to a formal hearing concerning his entering the horse "Casanova Way" at two different tracks within the five-day entry period. Mr. Serey scratched his horse from the 2nd race at Delaware Park on Saturday October 1, 2016, running the horse in the 1st race at Parx Racing on Tuesday, September 27, 2016. As a result of his actions which were deemed in violation of Commission rules 3.4, 3.4.1.15 and 11.2.12, Mr. Serey was fined the sum of \$1,000.00.

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:15 p.m. #7, “Huracan,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Could It Be Me,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 6

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:45 p.m. #7, “Lifes Reward,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Majestic Hope,” was eased by jockey Scott Spieth at the seven-eighths pole following the race. Acting Chief Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts examined the horse and reported that the horse appeared to have pulled a suspensory in the right front. Dr. Botts summoned the ambulance to transport the horse from the racing surface and return it to its barn.
