Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:18 p.m. Carol Cedeno, named on #1, “All About the Salsa,” was changed to Katie Davis; no double jocks mount. #2b, “Unto Thou,” was scratched as an alternate. #10, “On The Deadline,” was scratched by its trainer. #7, “My Darling Lizzie,” was scratched by the Stewards at the gate upon the recommendation of Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who stated the horse was not warming up well during the post parade.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:44 p.m. INQUIRY CONCERNING THE RUN DOWN THE BACKSTRETCH. – No hold or claim of foul - The #7, “Wanna Follow Me,” drifted in crowding the #3, “Big Saver,” ridden by Daniel Centeno and forcing the #1, “Musical Journey,” with Vince Halliday, into the rail, making the horse stumble with Mr. Halliday having to take up his horse. After interviewing the riders involved and based on video evidence, the Stewards disqualified the #7, from third and placed him seventh and last behind the #1 who was moved up from seventh to sixth. Jockeys Katie Davis, Daniel Centeno, and Vince Halliday are required to attend the film review for this race on Tuesday, October 18, 2016. Dyn Panell, named on #2, “Thepresidentallion,” was changed to James Vail; no double jocks mount. #6, “Neltherion,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Big Saver,” was claimed by Adam Staple – Michael Gorham. The trainer of the #7, “Wanna Follow Me,” Mr. Alan Bedard, filed a protest with the Stewards on the disqualification of his horse in this race. A film review will be conducted with Mr. Bedard on Tuesday, October 18, 2016 in the Stewards office.
