



Daily Log Stewards Report Delaware Park

Date: Monday, May 2, 2016 –to- Friday, May 6, 2016 prior to the 2016 racing season.

No Racing:

We are approving Racing Commission license applications. Filed post mortem reports on horses euthanized during the training only season. Reviewed and filed all Veterinarians daily treatment slips.

Monday, May 2, 2016 – Dr. Susan Botts is now the full time Acting Chief Commission Veterinarian. We are approving Racing Commission license applications. We talked to Dr. Botts about some issues in the test barn that needed repair. Dr. William Hawk came in this morning telling us that trainer Mr. Wayne Potts has paid his outstanding bill. We called trainer Mr. Louis Albertrani in this morning to serve a consent order issued by the state of Florida. The consent order was issued at 8:30 a.m. on Monday, May 2, 2016 in person, by Chief State steward Jack Houghton Jr.

Tuesday, May 3, 2016 – We approved Racing Commission license applications. Steward Fritz Burkhardt received a call from Ms. Bonnie Foster letting him know that the safety committee was to hold a meeting prior to the beginning of the 2016 racing season on Tuesday May 17, at 11: 30 a.m. Steward Jack Houghton called Delaware Parks MIS department to fix his phone. The MIS department had to come to the Stewards office to re-program the phone, as they said they had several phones go out with a glitch in the system. We spoke to several jockeys as they came in to be licensed today. We spoke to Dr. Botts about all practicing veterinarians, and their turning in of the daily treatment slips in a timely manner.

Wednesday, May 4, 2016 – We approved Racing Commission license applications. We called the Stewards at Tampa Bay Downs to have them contact a trainer, as the trainer needed to be licensed and turn in an employee badge list so his employees could get a license to take care of the horses that he has shipped here already. Steward Jack Houghton Jr. called Truesdail Laboratories Inc. about the price for workout samples, as we have trainers working horses here that were placed on vet's lists in other jurisdictions that the trainers have to pay for the testing procedure to get off the list. We requested that DTRC inspector Mr. Francis Swift contact some trainers that need to be licensed, and fill out employee badge lists.

Thursday, May 5, 2016 – We approved Racing Commission license applications. We issued licenses to several jockey agents today. We gave Dr. Botts copies of all the post mortem reports that we have had so far. We also talked to Dr. Botts about all the paperwork that the stewards needed from the Commission Vets office. We requested that DTRC inspector Mr. Francis Swift contact Dr. Amy Warren about some paperwork that needed to be turned in to the stewards. We talked to some trainers when touring the backside about the upcoming racing season. We discussed the times and naming of riders for the racing program, we will meet with the clerk of scales and racing secretary about this issue.

Friday, May 7, 2016 – We approved Racing Commission license applications. We received a phone call from owner Deborah Simpson, about collecting money from trainer Doug Seyler. Ms. Schumann was informed that a judgement from the state of Delaware was needed for the stewards to collect any outstanding money that was in dispute. We spoke to Salix office coordinator about procedures and issues for the upcoming racing season. The Stewards had a conference call with the Racing Secretary Jed Doro and his assistant Glenn Reeder, about the naming of riders for the race card. The Stewards typed up a memo which was sent to the racing secretary and approved for use, which is to be distributed and inserted in the condition book. DTI programmer Tony DiCiccio was here all day, working to get the computers up and running with new software.
