DSWA STARTING HOUSEHOLD HAZAROUS WASTE PILOT PROGRAM

The Delaware Solid Waste Authority (DSWA) is proud to announce the start of a new Household Hazardous Waste pilot program that would provide collection of Household Hazardous Waste every Friday over a nine-month period. The program, which will run from March 4, 2011 until November 25, 2011 at the Cheswold Collection Station, will offer residents the chance to dispose of Household Hazardous Waste every Friday from 8am-2pm. Household Hazardous Waste can include items such as household cleaners, garden pesticides, oil-based paints only (no latex paint will be accepted), nail polish, fluorescent bulbs, or antifreeze. During the event DSWA will not be able to accept any ammunition, prescription medication or sharps (needles). This event is restricted to Delaware residents only; no commercial services will be accepted. The event will be held rain or shine.

To mark the start of the program DSWA will hold special ribbon cutting ceremony on March 25 at 10am, at the Cheswold Collection Station located at 54 Fork Branch Road in Cheswold.

DSWA has always been proud to provide its Household Hazardous Waste collection events to the residents of Delaware. In 2010 DSWA expanded its program from 6 collection events to 10 events and now makes it more convenient for Delaware residents with the new pilot program events held every Friday.
