7-18-12: LIVE RACING WAS CANCELED FOLLOWING A MEETING AT 6:45 A.M. WITH DELAWARE PARK'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF RACING, MR. JOHN MOONEY CHIEF STATE STEWARD, JACK HOUGHTON JR. AND CHIEF COMMISSION VETERINARIAN, JOHN PETERS, THAT TEMPERATURES IN THE AREA POSED HEALTH RISKS FOR HORSES, RIDERS AND OTHER PARTICIPANTS.

The computers and phones were down for forty five minutes today as the power was off.

The draw for the Delaware Handicap post positions was held today at 11:00 a.m. with all three Stewards in attendance representing the Delaware Racing Commission. Refer to Delaware racing commission rule 3.4.1.2 : Stewards present until entries are drawn.

We conducted a hearing this morning for trainer Jorge Navarro for his treatment of the horse "Pot of Gold" with "Electrolytes" the day of the race. Mr. Navarro will be issued a fine of fifteen-hundred (\$1,500.00) dollars for this rule infraction. Mr. Navarro was given his appeal rights and will inform the Stewards within 24 hours of his decision.

We conducted three separate hearings on Tuesday July 17, 2012 for trainer Juan Vazquez concerning his three "Boldenone" positives. The Stewards are still deliberating on the sanction for these violations.

Trainer, Mr. Tom Amoss telephoned us requesting to put blinkers on the horse "Global Power" who was to be entered in the SUSSEX STAKES at Delaware Park on July 21, 2012. We contacted the Stewards at Mountaineer race track and asked them to review the performance of "Global Power" in its last race. The Mountaineer Stewards faxed a letter stating that the horse "Global Power" should be permitted to change equipment to "Blinkers-On," as the horse was "getting out" the entire race at Mountaineer. Consequently, we will allow the blinker change for the horse in this stakes race.

We held a hearing this morning for Jockey, Josue Arce for failure to follow proper licensing procedures. Mr. Arce was issued a warning and was required to perform the proper licensing procedure.

Jockey, Abel Mariano came in this morning expecting to be reinstated from his drug positive. Due to the fact that there are several more pending charges allegedly committed by Mr. Mariano still under investigation, we advised him that he would not be considered for reinstatement at this time. An administrative hearing will be scheduled regarding the allegations made against Mr. Mariano.

We fielded several phone calls from trainers shipping in wanting to know if we were racing on Thursday, July 19, 2012.

Horse I. D. Sharon Gunther called to scratch the horse "Smokette PS" from tomorrow's eighth race that was entered in the wrong race by mistake.

We received a trust agreement for Edward Moore Sr. from the trustees of his will, to Ms. Alicia Grande. We are sending this agreement to our attorney for further clarification.
