Approved scratches for today, veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for post racing vet's list workouts, which were all clear.

Administrative

We requested Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, talk to Trainer Mr. Bill Waldron about being close to the limit on the blood gas test for the eighth race on Saturday, May 19 2012. The horse "Sanddpipe," was close to the limit of 12.4 for Salix horses. With test sample results of 11.0 and 11.4 for total base excess levels Mr. Waldron was issued a warning. Dr. Peters reported that Mr. Waldron uses three products that are supplemented with sodium bicarbonate, but are not used on race days. Mr. Waldron was advised by the Stewards and Dr. Peters to discontinue or curtail the use of these products.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 pm. OFF TIME – 1:16 pm. ORDER OF FINISH – "1 - 6 - 2 - 5."

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 pm. OFF TIME – 1:45 pm. #3, "Notta Car," was selected for a blood gas test. ORDER OF FINISH – "2 - 1 - 6 - 5."

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 pm. OFF TIME – 2:18 pm. The rider on the #6, "Caleb's Prayer," Mr. Chase Miller was changed to Mr. Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 6 - 7 - 2."

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 pm. OFF TIME – 2:46 pm. #2, "Saxy Lady," was selected for a blood gas test. #5, "Hidden Love," who was ridden by Juan Molina Jr., was eased at the seven-eighths pole, pulling up after the race. The #5, "Hidden Love," was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters, who said the horse was off in the right front. Dr. Peters requested the horse ambulance to transport the horse back to its stall. ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 1 - 2 - 3."

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 pm. OFF TIME – 4:16 pm. The rider on the #7, “Ms Vanenza,” Mr. Joe Rocco Jr. was changed to Mr. Ricardo Santana Jr. by the trainer; no double Jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 7 - 2.”**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 pm. OFF TIME – 4:47 pm. #1, “Gabby’s Miracle,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Dial Direct,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Lulu Wong,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 – 1a - 5 - 3.”**

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:15 pm. OFF TIME – 5:18 pm. #2, “Deacon Furr,” was scratched by the racing office. #6, “Brother Bird,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Tizsilk,” #8, “Colbalt Cat,” and #10, “Alex’s Vision,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 1 - 3 - 9.”**
