SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:48 pm. OFF TIME – 3:53 pm. The
rider on #6, “Whata Soandoso,” Abel Castellano Jr. was changed to Daniel Centeno; No
double jocks mount. #13, “Kingdom,” and #14, “Lionintheweeds,” were scratched as
alternates. #1, “Stay I Insist,” bolted on the turn and continued bearing out. **ORDER OF**
FINISH – “12 - 11 - 6 - 3.”

Surprise,” requested a one hundred and seventy five (\$175.00) dollar all inclusive special
