On Monday, June 4, 2012 we requested Commission Inspector's Mr. Francis Swift and Mr. Ramon Rodriguez to conduct a search of the Jockeys quarters for Cell Phones, Computers, and I Pads. The Results of the search revealed that five Jockeys had Cell phones in their possession. A warning was issued to each Jockey and the names recorded as being given a warning, the next violation for these individuals will result in a penalty, under Delaware Racing Commission Rule 8.10.2.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 pm. OFF TIME – 1:16 pm. #6, “Cat in Motion,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 2 - 3.”**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:42 pm. OFF TIME – 1:46 pm. #1, “Bubbling Springs,” and #8, “Sting Boy,” were scratched as main track only. #2, “Later Gater,” and #3, “Bear’s Prospect,” were scratched as parts of same owner entries. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 – 2b – 1a.”**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:13 pm. OFF TIME – 2:14 pm. #2, “Loving Redemption,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #5, “Hurricane Girl,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #5, “Hurricane Girl,” requested a one hundred and seventy five (\$175.00) dollar all inclusive special test. #4, “Kukosa,” stumbled at the start, breaking slow. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 5 - 6.”**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:39 pm. OFF TIME – 2:40 pm. #4, “Ferris Face,” was a vet scratch. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 1 - 6.”**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:06 pm. OFF TIME – 3:09 pm. #3, “Longshore,” and #4, “Colony Strike,” were scratched as main track only. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 1 - 12.”** **INQUIRY FIRST TURN** – No claim of foul. It looked like the #12, “Art Class,” Geovany Garcia had taken hold of his horse when running up on the heels of the horses in front of him. Mr. Garcia’s horse drifted in a little, which in turn caused the #5, “Smart Power,” Malcolm Franklin to check his horse. No action was taken.

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:37 pm. OFF TIME – 3:38 pm. #4, “Culpepper Colonel,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #6, “Kaleidosound,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #6, “Kaleidosound,” requested a one hundred and seventy five (\$175.00) dollar all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 4 - 5.”** **INQUIRY START** – The #6, “Kaleidosound,” was acting up throwing his head to the right just as the starter started the race. The assistant starter let the horse loose but the horse pulled his hand over to the right. All the problems were caused by the horse acting up. No action was taken.

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:05 pm. OFF TIME – 4:09 pm. #10, “Night Seeker,” was scratched as a main track only. #14, “Edge of Glory,” was scratched as an alternate. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 12 - 6 - 9.”**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:37 pm. OFF TIME – 4:40 pm. #4, “Farley Hill,” and #9, “Noble Doss,” were vet scratches. #6, “Out to Conquer You,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 6 - 5.”**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:04 pm. OFF TIME – 5:08 pm. #1, “A F Big Red,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 2 - 3.”**

TENTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:34 pm. OFF TIME – 5:37 pm. The rider on the #1, “Chiquita Rose,” Victor Rodriguez was changed to Robert Paz, as Victor Rodriguez is riding the other part of a same owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 5 - 6.”**
