**Equine Forensic Drug Testing**

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates Wednesday May 30, Thursday, May 31, 2012 all tests were clear.

We received confirmation from Dalare Associates for the test's on hold from Thursday, May 24, 2012, the first one was sample #D-08242 from the winner, "Cat Wiesel" out of the second race. The second sample #D-07873 from the winner, "My Friend Dr Nick" out of the third race were positive for the drug "BOLDENONE," trade name, "EQUIPOISE".

We requested Commission Inspector's Mr. Francis Swift and Mr. Ramon Rodriguez to conduct a barn search this morning concerning the "BOLDENONE," positives. The barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer, Juan Vasquez were inspected. Results of the search did not reveal any contraband or evidence related to the positive tests.

Blood gas testing could not be conducted today as the blood gas machine could not be calibrated despite the efforts of Radiometer Technical Support. The samples drawn for today, will be tested on Saturday, June 9, 2012.

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 pm. OFF TIME – 1:48 pm.** #1, “Missnmesumu,” Joe Rocco Jr. was eased past the wire. We called Jockey Rocco who said the horse was not travelling well. We received a call from Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters at 1:34 p.m. stating that the blood gas machine was giving false readings and had to be re-calibrated. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 7 - 6.”**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:18 pm. OFF TIME – 2:19 pm.** #1a, “Conflicting Report,” scratched as part of a same owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 4 - 3.”**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 pm. OFF TIME – 2:46 pm.** #3, “Later Gater,” was scratched by the trainer. #6, “Sir Dynamite,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Veer,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #5, “Bubbling Springs,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vazquez. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 7 - 1.”**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 pm. OFF TIME – 3:19 pm.** #1, “Only One (ARG),” was scratched as a main track only. #2, “Saturday’s for Fun,” was selected for a blood gas test. We received a call from Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters at 3:11 p.m. stating that the blood gas machine was still giving false readings and could not be re-calibrated at this time. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 2 - 5.”**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 pm. OFF TIME – 3:46 pm.** #6, “Marie’s Babe,” was selected for a blood gas test. A claim in for the #5, “Pleasant Hymn,” by Hugh Robertson – Mclean Robinson was “VOID” as there was no money in the account for a claim. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 3 - 5.”**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 pm. OFF TIME – 4:18 pm.** #7, “Miscoe Gray,” was scratched as a main track only. #10, “Distinctive Alibi,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #14, “Sky Wars,” was scratched as an alternate. #4, “Shetan,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 12 - 2 - 8.”**

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:45 pm. OFF TIME – 4:46 pm.** The rider on the #5, “Marie’s Babe,” Juan Torres was changed to Robert Paz. No double jocks mount. #2, “Djent,” was scratched as part of a same owner entry. #3, “Valiant Boy SBFAR,” was scratched for being ineligible. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. Hold and claim of foul by the #4, “Mahra T,” Victor Rodriguez against the #6, “Chachie,” Juan Molina Jr. at the quarter pole for coming in and taking his room away. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the alleged incident, it looked to us as though there was plenty of room for the #4 to go through on the rail. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2b - 6 - 4 - 1.”**
