We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, June 6, and Thursday, June 7, 2012.

Administrative

The following Hearings are from Tuesday, June 12, 2012:

Exercise rider John Tatro came in 6-12-12 for a hearing concerning his positive test for alcohol. Commission inspector, Mr. Swift tested Mr. Tatro again for alcohol; the results indicated that he was still inebriated, with a test result of .128 which is over the legal limit of .05. Mr. Tatro will be required to attend and complete a drug and alcohol program with BEAP program director Mr. G. Wesley Jones II.

Veterinarian Luis Benitez was scheduled for a hearing today, for allegedly falsifying a health certificate. As a result of this hearing the Stewards are still in deliberation, as to a penalty for this violation.

We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #1a, “Smart Executive,” was selected for a blood gas test. After a two-way shake, #2, “Stoltz,” was claimed by Helen Kondor – Amanda Kondor. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 – 1a - 6.”**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:42 pm. OFF TIME – 1:43 pm. #3, “Molly B Good,” and #4, “Sneaky Predator,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 1 - 5.”**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:09 pm. OFF TIME – 2:10 pm. #1, “Lost Soul,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Belgian Beer,” was selected for a blood gas test. #7, “Flashy Bullet,” was claimed by Michael Cartwright, Owner-Trainer. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 5 - 6.”**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:36 pm. OFF TIME – 2:37 pm. #1, “Bob’s Redhead,” and #6, “Saving Elena,” were vet scratches. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 8 - 7 - 2.”**

FIFTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:05 pm. OFF TIME – 3:06 pm. #5, “Wingo Star,” and #8, “Ram,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #9, “Winsome Willie,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Saigon Story,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 7 - 2 - 3.”**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:33 pm. OFF TIME – 3:34 pm. #7, “Surprisedtoseeme,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Spring Pow Wow,” was pulled up at the top of the stretch. Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathleen Picciano examined the horse and diagnosed that it had sustained a fracture of its left rear leg. Due to the catastrophic injury, Dr. Picciano euthanized the horse. Post mortem report to follow. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 1 - 3.”**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:59 pm. OFF TIME – 4:02 pm. The rider on the #4, “Baby Flesh,” Alex Cintron was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr; no double jocks mount. #2, “Newfaster,” fell as he entered the track for the post parade, unseated the rider, and thereafter ran off. The horse was caught by the track personnel in the chute. Following examination by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters, he recommended to the Stewards that the horse be scratched. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 7 - 3.”**

EIGHTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:28 pm. OFF TIME – 4:29 pm. #1, “Nekia’s Vow,” #2, “Feels Good,” #6, “Our Gin Mill,” #7, “Gadget,” #8, “Swing Even,” and #9, “Forever Diva,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. We canceled Show, Trifecta, and Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 5 - 3 - 4.”**

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:55 pm. OFF TIME – 4:56 pm. The rider on the #1a, “See I A,” Daniel Centeno was changed to Able Castellano Jr. as Mr. Centeno is riding the other part of the same-owner entry; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #4, “Homeboykris,” Yomar Orlando Ortiz was changed to Angel Suarez; double jocks mount will be charged. The rider on the #5, “One Ocean Drive,” Alex Cintron was changed to Kendrick Carmouche. No double jocks mount. #3, “Rusty Charlie,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. The #1, “Sneak a Cold Treat,” was claimed by Barbara Rushing – Jonas Gibson. The #6, “Leavenworth,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #6, “Leavenworth,” requested a one-hundred- seventy-five dollar (\$175.00) all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 5 – 1a - 6.”**
