Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, ambulance transport reports from management and blood gas test results.

### Equine Forensic Drug Testing

We received test clearances from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, July 25, and Thursday, July 26, 2012, which were all clear.

### Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday July 31, 2012 for trainer Mr. Jamie Ness concerning his "PHENYLBUTAZONE" positive, in the amount of 13.8 micrograms per milliliter of plasma for the horse "Sorry No Refunds" from the sixth race on Wednesday, July 11, 2012. Mr. Ness was assessed a five-hundred (\$500.00) dollar fine, and a seven (7) day suspension. In addition the horse "Sorry No Refunds" will be disqualified from all purse money. Mr. Ness was furnished with information about his right to appeal. Mr. Ness advised that would appeal the 7day suspension portion of the ruling and would not contest the fine or purse redistribution.

We also had a hearing scheduled for jockey agent Roniel Gerado Rodriguez, for failure to conduct his business in a proper manner. Mr. Rodriguez waived his right to a hearing and will be assessed a two-hundred (\$200.00) dollar fine, for naming his rider on horses and then having his rider ride at another race track.

A trainers test was administered by the Stewards to Ms. Cathy Denelsbeck on July 31, 2012. Ms. Denelsbeck is currently licensed as a horse owner.

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. #5, “Fast Friend,”** was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #12, Takful Lady,” #13, “Dance with Sandy,” and #14, “Rondas Back,” were scratched as alternates. #4, “Girlsruletheworld,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 8 - 10 - 1.”** **Starters - 10**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. #1a, “See I A,”** was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Ooohs and Aaahs,” was selected for a blood gas test. At the start, the #2, “Laughter,” ridden by Angel Suarez broke to the right hitting the gate, causing the rider to lose his right stirrup. Mr. Suarez got his foot back into the stirrup at about the half-mile pole and finished the race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 3 - 2.”** **Starters - 6**

**EIGHTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. #7, “Dances on the Seas,”** was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #3, “Sutton Road,” and #9, “A Single man,” were scratched as main-track only. #13, “Orchestra Leader,” was scratched by the trainer. #14, “Darlin’s Terms,” was scratched as an alternate. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 4 - 1.”** **Starters - 9**

**NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:18 p.m. #1a, Taishaa,”** was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Tikis Sandy Vaz,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #5, “Our Ruby Rose,” Juan Torres broke though the gate prior to the start, and was immediately caught by the outrider. “Our Ruby Rose” was returned to the starting gate where it was examined by Dr. Jane Teichner advising in her opinion, that the horse was fit to race. Jockey Torres advised that he was uninjured, as he had stepped off the horse in the gate. The #1, “Destinee LZP,” Gregorio Rivera, was eased walking across the finish line. Dr. Teichner called informing us that the horse “Destinee LZP” had a breathing problem. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 3 - 6.”** **Starters - 6**
