We approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Saturday, August 18, and Monday, August 20, 2012, were all clear.

Administrative Hearings:

A hearing was held this morning for groom, Marvin Parada, for damaging track property in the stable area, not having a vehicle pass, and disorderly conduct. As a result of the hearing Mr. Parada was suspended until full restitution is paid to Delaware Park for damages incurred. Mr. Parada is further ordered to be evaluated by the horsemen's Drug and Alcohol counselor, before being eligible for licensing.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Es La Mia (ARG),” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #7, “Economic Stimulus,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 7 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 8**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:43 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:45 p.m. The rider on the #7, “Arnie’s Honor,” Vince Halliday, was changed to Martin Solis; double jocks mount will be charged. #1, “Black Seal,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THREE EIGHTS POLE –** The rider on the #3, “Presidential Colors,” Victor Rodriguez drifted out at the three-eighths pole, bumping with the #4 which caused his horse, the #3, to stumble and fall. Mr. Rodriguez was examined by Melissa Seibert at First Aid who stated that Mr. Rodriguez appeared to be ok, not complaining of any adverse effects from being unseated. Mr. Rodriguez signed a refusal of treatment form, returning to the jockey’s quarters. The horse #3, “Presidential Colors,” was uninjured in this fall. THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. The rider on the #2, “Bubbling Springs,” Victor Rodriguez, was changed to Yamil Rosario, as Mr. Rodriguez was unseated in the second race, and will be sitting out this race per-order of the Stewards; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 7 - 6.” Starters - 7**

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. The rider on the #1a, “Saigon Story,” Victor Rodriguez, was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #5, “Garp,” Osvaldo Vargas, was changed to Yamil Rosario, as Mr. Rodriguez is riding the other part of a same-owner entry; no double jocks mount. #2, “Revelator,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Chuckie’s Honor,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. We received a call from the jockey’s room stating that the rider on the #3, “Universal Soul,” Yomar Orlando Ortiz wanted us to look at the race again, telling us that the rider of the #1, “Nico the Champ,” Victor Rodriguez had pushed him with his hand at the quarter pole. After reviewing the films the rider of the #1 does push the rider of the #3 with his hand on the turn at the quarter pole. Movies will be held Monday, August 27, for this race. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 1 – 1a - 5.” Starters - 7**

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #3, “Zany Viola,” was scratched due to an expired coggins. #1, “Bayside Seabrez,” and #6, “Ebony Street,” were vet scratches. #10, “Nisbet,” #11, “Laurie’s Spirit,” #12, “Emily’s Spirit,” and #13, “Ronda’s Back were scratched as alternates. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 2 - 7 - 14.” Starters - 7**

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. The rider on the #1, “Coin of the Realm,” Daniel Centeno, was changed to Oliver Castillo; no double jocks mount. #2, “Troika,” was selected for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 4 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 7**

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. The rider on the #9, “Lady Olivia,” Jonathan Joyce, was changed to Yamil Rosario; no double jocks mount. #1, “Smart Cash,” and #7, “E. T. Indy,” were scratched as main-track only. #6, “Holiday Fashion,” was selected for a blood gas test. #9, “Lady Olivia,” was selected for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 10 – 1a.” Starters - 9**

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. #1, “Tonto Fontenot,” was a vet scratch. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #5, “Bid Til Included,” reared up just as the doors to the starting gate opened, breaking slowly. We called the rider of the #5, Jose Caraballo who confirmed that the horse went up in the air just as doors to the starting gate opened. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 6**
