We approved scratches for today, reviewed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

Movies were held today regarding two races from Saturday, August 25, 2012. The second race at the three-eighths pole and the fourth race at the quarter-pole, were reviewed.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

We received a positive test result for Sample D-9132 collected from the horse “Day Dream Girl,” who had been euthanized, after finishing second in the seventh race on Wednesday, August 15, 2012. The sample was positive for “Trenbolone”™ Finoplix which is a steroid growth hormone. We requested Commission Inspectors Francis Swift and Ramon Rodriguez to conduct a barn search this morning concerning the “Trenbolone” positive. The barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer, Carla Morgan were inspected. Results of the search did not reveal any contraband. Ms. Morgan came in this morning, being advised of her right to a split sample and hearing options for this violation.

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #3, “Worthy Wager,” and #5, “Snap It,” were vet scratches. #4, “Ikan,” was selected for a blood gas test. The main track has been upgraded to FAST starting this race. ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #5, “Wendybird,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Lily of Johar,” #1a, “Our Gin Mill,” #3, “Castle Creeping,” and #9, “Tippie Tap,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #4, “Embracing Hearts,” was claimed by Southern Springs Stables – Ron Moquett. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 5**

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. #5, “Heaven’s Voice,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Sing It Again,” was claimed by PTK LLC – Dane Kobiskie. The owner and trainer that claimed the #6, “Sing It Again,” requested a one hundred and seventy five (\$175.00) dollar all inclusive special test. #7, “Mis Vizcaya,” was claimed by Southern Springs Stables – Ron Moquett. #4, “Island Blossom,” was selected for a Stewards special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 8**

EIGHTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:45 p.m. #2, “Bring Your a Game,” and #7, “Hard Drive,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #14, “Easton Jack,” was scratched as a main-track only. #10, “Distorted Appeal,” #12, “Cusabo,” and #13, “Chilkoot Trail,” were scratched as alternates. #6, “Beansntaters,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 9 - 3 - 11.” Starters - 8**

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS “THE 19th RUNNING OF THE BOB MAGNESS MEMORIAL ARABIAN DERBY (Grade II)” - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:17 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE QUARTER POLE - #5, “Nouveau Rich,” bolted at the top of the stretch, unseating jockey, Oliver Castillo. Consequently, Mr. Castillo fell in front of the path of the #3, ‘Born To Boogie MC,’ ridden by Ricardo Santana Jr., who could not avoid the fallen rider. Jockey Castillo was taken to the hospital for observation. The horse #5, “Nouveau Rich,” will be placed on the Stewards list. #6, “Sammy V,” pulled up lame after the race. Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano advised in her opinion that the horse pulled a right suspensory. The horse was taken off the racing surface by the horse ambulance upon the recommendation of Dr. Picciano. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 7**
