We approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

Post-race test results from Dalare Associates for Wednesday, August 22, and Thursday, August 23, 2012, were all clear.

**Administrative Hearings:**

Following a review of the racing films for the second and fourth races on Saturday, August 25, 2012 regarding apprentice jockey, Victor Rodriguez, will receive a suspension for the remainder of the 2012 meet at Delaware Park. This decision is for extremely careless riding at the three eighths pole causing his horse to clip heels and fall in the second race on Saturday, August 25, 2012; and also for the fourth race on Saturday, August 25, 2012 for pushing another rider with his hand during the running of the race at the quarter pole.

We held a hearing this morning concerning the “Stanozolol” positive for trainer Donald Barr. The positive concerned the horse “Warrensburg”; who had won the third race on Monday, August 6, 2012. Mr. Barr will be fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars; he will also receive a seven (7) day suspension. In addition the horse “Warrensburg” will be disqualified from all purse money.

**Administrative:**

A trainers test was administered by the Stewards to Mr. Benjamin J. Ritchey on Tuesday, August 28, 2012; Mr. Ritchey passed the written examination and will be issued a certificate for this accomplishment.

was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** The rider on the #7, “Elizabeth Lane,” Victor Rodriguez, was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr.; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 4 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.** #6, “Shameless,” was scratched as a main-track only. #5, “Pi Bella,” was selected for a blood gas test. #5, “Pi Bella,” pulled up lame after the race. “Pi Bella,” was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters, who diagnosed the horse’s condition as being off in the left front. The Stewards requested the horse ambulance to transport, and return the horse to its stall. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 4 - 3 - 2.” Starters - 7**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.** #4, “Be Widget,” was scratched, as the groom had brought the wrong horse to the paddock for the race. The horse brought for the fourth race was entered in the seventh race. **INQUIRY AT START –** The #1, “Golden Rock,” hesitated at the start, just standing in the gate when the doors opened. After reviewing the films of the race, the assistant starter had let the horse loose but the #1 just stood a few seconds before breaking. The rider, Mr. Cintron said the horse was standing perfect, but hesitated breaking very slow. No action was taken. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 5**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m.** The rider on the #8, “Love The Heat,” Jonathan Joyce, was changed to Wesley Ho; no double jocks mount. #1, “Avilord,” was scratched for failure to have the foal certificate on file. #7, “Wuthering,” was a vet scratch. #11, “More Tea Vicar,” was scratched as an alternate. **ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 3 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 8**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m.** #8, “Hidden Joy,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 8**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m.** Victor Rodriguez, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Overnight Fling,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Travelin Dream,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 7**

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:45 p.m.** The rider on the #7, “Tiki Barber,” Victor Rodriguez, was changed to Juan Molina; no double jocks mount. #1, “Burnin Rubber,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Chrysler,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Aim South,” was claimed by Rosebrook Farm LLC – Randy Nunley. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 5 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 6**

The rider on the #5, “Baccarat City,” Esteban Unsihuay, was changed to Juan Molina, due to a misunderstanding by the clerk of scales; no double jocks mount. #4, “Kory LZP,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Tikis Sandy Vaz,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 3 - 7.” Starters - 6**
