Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #7, “Will Unbridled,”**  
was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 5 - 1.” Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #5, “Midnight Exchange,”**  
was scratched for track conditions. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 6**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.** During the running of the race the rider of the #6, “Classy Broad,” Daniel Centeno, was hit in the face by an unknown object at the eighth pole. Following the race, jockey Centeno pulled the horse up at the seven-eighths pole and dismounted. Jockey Centeno was examined by EMT, C. Lancaster at first aid, signed a refusal of treatment form and will resume riding. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.** Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Hi Ho Bambino,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr. as Mr. Centeno was taken off by the Stewards, to sit at least one race; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #7, “Rockaby Bay,” Kendrick Carmouche, was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #8, “Vigilante Law,” Ricardo Santana Jr., was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. #10, “Judge Well,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Don’twait Toolong,” #2, “Inauguration,” #5, “Great Harbour,” and #9, “Safety Valve,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #11, “R. B. Float,” was scratched as an alternate. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 8 - 3.” Starters - 5**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m.** #1, “Miss Laura Jean,” was pulled up at the top of the stretch by its rider, Yomar Orlando Ortiz, and dismounted. “Miss Laura Jean,” was examined by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters, who preliminarily diagnosed that the horse sustained injury to its left front sesamoid. Dr. Peters requested the horse ambulance transport the injured horse from the racing surface. Further examination by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Kathleen Picciano determined that the horse had sustained multiple fractures to its left front carpal (knee). After consulting with trainer, Sam Cronk, the conditioner of “Miss Laura Jean,” it was determined that the horse would be humanely destroyed. **ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 3 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 8**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m.** Joshua Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Terraphic Warrior,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. We had a three-minute delay due to heavy rain. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:15 p.m.** #3, “Richie the Thief,” #6, “Manacor (IRE),” and #10, “D’oro Dancer,” were vet scratches. #1, “Hold True,” #4, “Brand New Moves,” and #8, “Kingofthehighceas,” were scratched as this race is off the turf. #11, “Personal Fight,” and #12, “Ghostly Chant,” were scratched as alternates. #5, “Win for the Zipper,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 5 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 4**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:46 p.m.** Daniel Centeno, the scheduled rider on the #1, “My Charming Clyde,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr.; no double jocks mount. The rider on the #5, “It’s Never to Late,” Jose Montano, was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Escort,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Mass Destruction,” and #4, “Streetsofbrooklyn,” were scratched on account of track conditions. #8, “Grand Sensation,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Bet the Power,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 5**

**NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:15 p.m.** Santos Chavez, the scheduled rider on the #4, “MD Sterling Silver,” was changed to Ricardo Santana Jr.; no double jocks mount. #2, “Doc Holidday,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Time and Change,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 5**
